Forage Tetraploid Annual Ryegrass

Amp is an early maturing, tetraploid annual ryegrass developed for increased forage matter production and high sugar content that animals crave. It has great rust resistance, deep roots, high vigor during establishment and superior early spring growth. Amp has a high level of nonstructural carbohydrates and good palatability making it an excellent choice for early spring grazing or haylage.

- Seeding Rate (pure stand): 30-40 pounds per acre
- Seeding Rate (interseeding): 15-20 pounds per acre
- Seeding Rate (covercrop): 10-15 pounds per acre
- Planting Depth: 1/4—1/2 inch
