All interested persons are encouraged to attend in person and comment on Ordinance Title XI, Sec. 119, A temporary ordinance regarding the issuance of local medical cannabis establishment permits and/or licenses. After the public hearing, the Planning Commission may pass a resolution recommending approval of Ordinance Title XI, Sec. 119, with or without amendment, to the Board of Commissioners. The Board of Commissioners may then have the first reading of Ordinance Title XI, Sec. 119 by title and set a 2<sup>nd</sup> reading date.

The proposed Ordinance Title XI, Sec. 119 will be made available for public inspection at Summerset City Hall located at 7055 Leisure Lane, Summerset, SD and on-line at <a href="https://www.summerset.sd">www.summerset.sd</a> pursuant to SDCL Section 11-4 and amendments thereto.

## A TEMPORARY ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF LOCAL MEDICAL CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENT PERMITS AND/OR LICENSES.

WHEREAS, a local government may enact an ordinance not in conflict with SDCL Chapter 34-20G, governing the time, place, manner, and number of medical cannabis establishments in the locality. A local government may establish civil penalties for violation of an ordinance governing the time, place, and manner of a medical cannabis establishment that may operate in the locality. A local government may require a medical cannabis establishment to obtain a local license, zoning permit, or registration to operate, and may charge a reasonable fee for the local license, zoning permit, or registration.

WHEREAS, the City of Summerset, SD ("Summerset"), by and through the Board of Commissioners, makes a preliminary finding that Summerset's current regulations and controls may not adequately address the unique needs and impacts of medical cannabis establishments as defined in SDCL 34-20G-1;

WHEREAS, medical cannabis state laws under SDCL 34-20G are effective July 1, 2021. The South Dakota Department of Health shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 not later than October 29, 2021, as defined by SDCL 34-20G-72. During the time between July 1, 2021 and potentially as late as October 29, 2021, local units of government will not yet know standards for medical cannabis and will not be able to adequately assess the local zoning and licensing requirements necessary to approve local permits and to better ensure applicants have a more predictable permitting process and avoid stranded investments.

WHEREAS, Summerset makes a preliminary finding that it needs further study of the relationship of medical cannabis establishments to Summerset's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance. The public interest requires that Summerset study, analyze, and evaluate the impacts of medical cannabis establishments and to fully explore the impacts of any proposed regulations regarding medical cannabis establishments;

WHEREAS, Summerset makes a preliminary finding that it would be inappropriate for Summerset to issue a local permit or license to a medical cannabis establishment prior to the South Dakota Department of Health's promulgation of regulations governing the same;

WHEREAS, Summerset hereby exercises its authority under SDCL 11-4-3.1 and/or SDCL 9-19-13, to establish a temporary ordinance regarding the issuance of any local permits/licenses for medical cannabis establishments within the City of Summerset;

WHEREAS, a temporary ordinance will ensure that more comprehensive zoning ordinance and building permit changes, licensing permits, and any proposed amendments to Summerset's Comprehensive Plan can be completely examined with adequate public input from citizens, business interests, and medical cannabis industry representatives;

WHEREAS, Summerset finds that a temporary ordinance is reasonable to preserve the status quo and prevent significant investment pending the outcome of the above study and any proposed regulations emanating therefrom;

WHEREAS, Summerset finds that the following ordinance is necessary to protect and immediately preserve the public health, safety, welfare, peace and support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SUMMERSET, SD:

Section 1. Temporary Ordinance – Application for Local Permit/License

A medical cannabis establishment desiring to operate in the City of Summerset shall be required to apply for a permit and/or license from the municipality. Applications for a local permit and/or license to operate a medical cannabis establishment, as defined by SDCL 34-20G-1, shall not be accepted until the South Dakota Department of Health has promulgated regulations as required by SDCL 34-20G-72. Any application received prior to such regulations being promulgated shall be denied.

# ORDINANCE No. \_\_\_\_AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSUMPTION OR SMOKING OF CANNABIS IN PUBLIC PLACES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Summerset Board of Commissioners that Title XIII, Chapter 131: Offenses Against Public Peace of the Ordinances of the City of Summerset is hereby amended by adding new Section 131.13 indicating text to be deleted, <u>underline</u> indicating text to be added, and the remainder of the Article left unaffected-as follows:

Title XIII: General Offenses

Chapter 131: Offenses Against Public Peace

## Sec. 131.13. Consumption or smoking of cannabis in public places prohibited.

(a) It is unlawful for any person to consume or smoke cannabis in any public place including parks, sidewalks, streets, alleys, rights-of-way, sports complexes, publicly owned property, or in any place that is open to the public.

(1) A place open to the public is a place to which the public is invited, included in, on, or around any place of business, parking lot, or place of amusement or entertainment, whether or not a charge of admission or entry thereto is required and includes the elevator, lobby, halls, corridors, and areas open to the public of any store, office or multifamily residential building even if such place charges an admission or limits the number of admittees.

\* \* \*

Severability. The provisions of this ordinance arc severable. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

Immediate Effect. This ordinance is necessary to protect and immediately preserve the public health, safety, welfare, peace, and support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions pursuant to SDCL 11-4-3.1 and SDCL 9-19-13.
