Contributions are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. Under federal law, individuals may contribute a maximum of \$2,900 for the special election and \$2,900 for the run-off election. Couples may make contributions from a joint account, but each contributor must sign the check (or other written instrument) or a statement that accompanies the contribution. Qualified federal PACs may contribute a maximum of \$5,000 for the special election and \$5,000 for the run-off election. Non-qualified federal PACs may contribute a maximum of \$2,900 for the primary election and \$2,900 for the general election. Contributions from federal government contractors and corporations are prohibited. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in an election cycle.

Congressman Jake Ellzey decided to become a fighter pilot when, at age seven, his dad took him on his first plane ride.

A graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy, Congressman Jake Ellzey served as a fighter pilot and completed his service as the Air Boss on the U.S.S. Ronald Reagan aircraft carrier. In his 20 years of service, Congressman Ellzey was deployed nine times, including to Afghanistan and Iraq. He served five combat tours by air and one by ground with Seal Team 5.

For his service, Congressman Jake Ellzey received two Bronze Stars and eight Air Medals. After retiring from the military, he became a successful local businessman, a commercial airline pilot, and served Texas as Commissioner on the Texas Veterans Commission. He was even appointed to be Chairman of the Commission by Governor Rick Perry. Today, Congressman Ellzey is a commercial airline pilot-based out of DFW. And, Jake serves in the Texas House of Representatives where he sits on the House Energy Resources committee, Licensing and Administrative Procedures and Local & Consent Calendars committees

Jake and his wife Shelby are raising their two children, McCall and Jack, on ten acres in Ellis County.

Most Americans look to Texas for the way forward for prosperity and freedom and liberty. Congressman Jake Ellzey understands that what happens in Washington DC could threaten all of that. On July 27th, Congressman Jake Ellzey was elected to the United State House of Representatives.
