## General Assistance Notice

The municipality of Baldwin administers a General Assistance Program for people in need. Pursuant to Title 22 MRSA-4304, the Municipal Officers have adopted an Ordinance establishing the General Assistance program. Copies of the Municipal Ordinance and General Assistance statutes are available, upon request, for public inspection at the Town Office and on the Town website [baldwinmaine.org](http://baldwinmaine.org).

Persons who wish to apply for General Assistance may do so during regular business hours by calling 207-632-2240 or by coming into the Town Office. Applicants are encouraged to call 207-632-2240 to schedule a phone or in person appointment ahead of time.

In the event of a **LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCY**, occurring after normal business hours applicants may contact **Cumberland County Emergency Dispatch** 207-893-2810 and ask them to contact the General Assistance Administrator.

The municipality's General Assistance administrator must issue a written decision within 24 hours of receiving an application.
