## September Workshop - Thangles! Quick & Easy Half Square Triangles



What in the world is a “Thangle”?? How do they work? Thangles are paper templates used as a quick and easy way to make half square triangles. You won’t have to use 7/8” math or square up every piece. All you do is cut straight grain strips.

Pam Fenoff will teach us how to use Thangles for a Chevron Stripes Quilt Block.

Thangles templates will be furnished for class. Bring your normal sewing supplies, including a cutting mat, rotary cutter and three (3) coordinating fabrics...

For a 9” block (w/ 1 1/2” finished squares)  
one light - 2 strips cut to 9 1/2” x 4 3/4”  
one medium - 1 strip, same cut  
one dark - 1 strip, same cut

OR...

For a 9” block (w/ 2 1/4” finished squares)  
**one light - 4 strips cut to 7” x 2 3/4”**  
**one medium - 2 strip, same cut**  
**one dark - 2 strip, same cut**

Sounds like a fun class! Hope to see you there.
