He stated a lot of municipalities across the country are laying employees off, getting no pay increases and deferring large capital purchases. He said, fortunately Fountain Inn is in a financial position that we are able to add personnel, give pay increases, increase some operating expenditures and still be able to make capital and facility upgrades.

Finance Director, Naomi Reed reviewed the budget process, highlights and council goals as she presented the proposed 2020-2021 budget. (Power Point attached)

Mrs. Reed stated a called council meeting/public hearing and first reading of the budget will be June 4, 2020 at 6pm.


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### City Administrator Report
