

CARL H. BEYER

1913 - 1995

Carl H. Beyer, 82 of Sebawaing, passed away Sunday, April 16 at the Huron Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe following a one-year illness.

He was born Jan. 10, 1913 in Sebawaing, son of the late August and Augusta (Malatska) Beyer. He was united in marriage to Dorothy E. Holcomb on Nov. 21, 1941 in Saginaw. She survives him.

Mr. Beyer had been employed by General Motors in Saginaw as a pattern maker for 27 years, until entering the Army Air Force during World War II. He then was transferred to the General Motors Truck Plant in Flint and retired there as a 30-year retiree. Mr. and Mrs. Beyer had resided in Saginaw until moving to Flint in 1951. They lived in Flint until moving to Sebawaing in 1989.

He was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebawaing and a member of the Local 659, UAW.

Surviving are his wife, Dorothy, Pigeon; one daughter, Carla J. Maynard, Marco Island, FL; one stepson, James (Dorothy) Holcomb, Merrillville, IN; nine grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; two brothers, Herman Beyer, Arcadia, FL and Reinhold Beyer, Albuquerque, NM; one sister, Olga Dodi, Sterling Heights and several nieces and nephews.

One brother, Harold Beyer and one sister, Martha Bryer both preceded him in death.

The funeral service will take place on Wednesday, April 19 at 11 a.m. at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebawaing. Rev. Martin Hagenow will officiate with burial in the church cemetery.

Friends may call at the Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home in Sebawaing from 3 to 9 p.m. on Tuesday. He will lie in state at the church from 9:30 a.m. Wednesday until the time of service.
