

## **SUMMARY OF BIG PICTURE IDEAS THAT CAME FROM THE 100+ WHO ATTENDED**

### **IDENTITY**

Create new community and cultural centers – rehab of existing City-owned property.

Ensure that new construction is contextual and compatible with the neighborhood.

Preserve and re-use historic buildings.

Protect and Enhance Sense of Place of Calle 8.

### **MOVEMENT**

Create more trolley routes and improve trolley service.

Improve transit connections to major employment centers – Downtown and the Airport: Create a water taxi along the Miami River; create a transit loop.

Identify neighborhood centers and provide convenient and safe multi-modal connections between them and to employment centers.

Support and improve safe and convenient pedestrian and bicycle movement through the neighborhood.

### **SAFETY**

Improve pedestrian safety on sidewalks/safe crosswalks.

Provide better lighting in alleys, bus stops, public spaces, and parks.

Calm speeding traffic.

Convert one-way streets to two-way streets.

Reduce crime for safety at home and in the streets.

## **STEWARDSHIP/TAKING CARE/EMPOWERMENT**

Ensure that housing and businesses are affordable and accessible for the community.

Maintain existing buildings as decent places to live.

Create an approach for compassionate code compliance.

Keep streets clean by reducing litter and maintaining infrastructure / landscape.

Support multicultural and multigenerational living spaces.

Keep the younger generation in Little Havana as they grow.

## **NATURE**

Create more parks and open space and improve access to existing parks.

Plant more trees on private and public property.

Create more shade.

Improve access to the riverfront.
