Procedures

- K-2 will attend five days a week regardless of the district being in green or yellow. The reason for this is because of their already small class size.
- There will be no open campus or honors study hall. We have made these changes due to temperature checking and limiting the contact our students could potentially have during the school day. We will revisit this issue before the second semester.
- Our main priority is to keep our students and staff sage. For this reason, all doors will be locked and finger print access will be turned off during school hours. All parents, guests, and community members will be required to check in at the front office. For entrance into the school, your temperature will be taken. If you have a temperature of 100.4 or above or are showing any symptoms of illness, you will not be allowed to enter the building. During any point of the year, if the school district moves to the "yellow" or "red" phase, the building will be closed to the public.
- The drop-off procedure for school will be as follows: K-3 will be screened and admitted into the building at the elementary doors. 4th-7th grade will be screened and must enter through the commons door. 8th-12th grade will be screened and must enter through the high school doors. All back doors will be locked. If a student's temperature is at 100.4 or higher or shows any signs of illness, they will be required to put a mask/face shield on and will be sent home immediately. It is important we all do our part during this pandemic. For this reason, I ask that if your child is not feeling well, please keep them home.
- For student pick up, all students will exit out of the south side doors. We are asking that parents please wait outside of the building to pick up your student and maintain social distancing guidelines.
- In the case we have to move into the "yellow" phase, we will be using a blended school model. This will most likely indicate we are seeing community spread in Daniels County. Half of the student body will come to school every other day while masks/face shields will be required.

Each family will receive a letter detailing the in-class/distance learning rotation for their child/children.

Students in the same family will have the same rotation schedule.

• If we move into the "Red" phase, the school will be closed until the health department allows us to return to the building. During this time, our students will be receiving their education through distance learning.
