#### **Message From the President**

As we enter October, I hear the voice of Nat "King" Cole singing, "The falling leaves drift by my window, The autumn leaves of red and gold...". What could be more pleasant than low humidity, daytime temps in the 70s and low 80s, and overnight temps dropping into the upper 50s?

Yes, Actual Fall is finally here. Take advantage of it while you can! At its September meeting, the Board approved a 2025/2026 Snow Removal & Salting contract proposal from ZGreen Landscaping, reminding us that winter is just around the corner.

Speaking of seasons... it is Budget Season here at Village Green. Christian presented Draft 1 of the 2026 Operating Budget to the Board in September. We discussed the increasing costs of wages and employee benefits, including health insurance, property, liability, umbrella, D&O, and workers' compensation insurance, as well as building & equipment maintenance, sprinkler system maintenance, utilities, contributions to the reserve fund, and legal and bad debt expenses. On the revenue side, we discussed expected investment interest income and modest increases in fees for meals, garages, and extra storage units.

We'll review Draft 1 of the Capital Budget in October. At the November meeting, we'll approve tentative versions of both the Operating and Capital Budgets for distribution to Owners. Final budgets will be adopted in December and also distributed to the Owners.

In addition to the three dry sprinkler systems in the attic above the third floor, there is a fourth dry system that covers the first-floor offices, common areas, and the canopy out front. Until recently, the fourth system was trouble-free. It has now begun having problems, so it has been added to the planning process for sprinkler system replacement. We'll be reviewing bid specifications and a timeline for bidding out the project at the October Board Meeting.

Did you know... Illinois will lose approximately one hour and 17 minutes of daylight between October 1 and October 31, 2025. The day length decreases by an average of about 2 minutes and 33 seconds per day. Thank goodness for our new and brighter LED lighting at building entrances and behind the garage!
