As Chief Equity Officer, Dr. Karen McKinney is working to make the Minnesota Department of Human Services an anti-racist institution. Before joining DHS, she spent 24 years at Bethel University as a professor in the Biblical & Theology Studies Department.



For the last five years, McKinney also served as the community liaison to communities of color for the University's Office of Diversity. Prior to that, she held a variety of positions in youth ministry, health care and education and served as a consultant on anti-racism, equity, and diversity.
