

Float Stroke

- a. Dampen the Shader with water.
- b. Pat out excess water on a paper towel.
- c. Corner load the left corner with thinned Color.
- d. Pat blend color and water on a clean area of palette with the Shader on the flat.

Detailing with a Liner

- a. Thin color to light cream.
- b. Hold the brush almost straight up.
- c. Change the pressure on tip to achieve thinner and broader lines.
- d. Fully load the Liner.
- e. For the scroll work, the round outlining of grapes and peaches refer to the "How Too" box.
- f. Practice this style of outlining before completing the bowl.

Tracing

Use the Tissue Paper style for tracing, to apply the design:

- a. Trace the provided design onto an inexpensive piece of tissue paper with standard pencil.
- b. Align the traced design onto the ware.
- c. Using Ultra-fine Black Sharpie Permanent Marker, trace over the penciled design on the tissue paper. The Sharpie will bleed through the tissue just enough for you to see the pattern.
- d. Please note, only to use the Ultra-fine tip. To heavy of an application of ink could and does repeal some fired colors. (the marker will fire out)
