Sliding	Players must AVOID contact when there is a play at the base they are going to; otherwise, they risk being called out. <i>(this is a judgement call by the umpire)</i>		
Line-ups: Player Rotations	Players cannot sit for consecutive innings (including extra innings)		
Position Requirements	All players play minimum of one inning in infield, if safe and they choose to (regular season only)		
Calling up players from Minor League teams <i>Note: Coaches are responsible for notifying League Director of call-ups so that limits can be monitored.</i>	<p>Allowed if team is expected to have less than 10 players at any point in game. Call ups:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) must be 12 years old (Spring), or 11 yrs old (summer/fall) unless approved by League Director or President b) must not have another game scheduled for the same time c) may not start ahead of a rostered player d) must play at least two innings e) may not pitch f) must bat last in line-up g) may not play more innings than a rostered player h) may not play more than two innings at the same position i) may not play more than two innings total in infield (including catcher) j) should wear their own uniform so to be identifiable by opposing coach 		
Call-up limits	No more than three games in a row and a total of five games in a season (including playoffs)	No more than two games in a row and a total of four games in a season (including playoffs)	
Borrowing players from other Major League teams <i>Note: Coaches are responsible for notifying League Director of players borrowed so that limits may be monitored.</i>	n/a	CRITERIA: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) 1 player if team is down to 9 players (2 if 8, etc); b) Must be of the same ranking or below and not playing at the same time; c) Can borrow a #2 pitcher if #1 pitcher not available; d) #1 pitchers may be borrowed as positional players only

Rescheduling Weather-Related Games	Make-up dates must be established with 48 hours of the originally scheduled game, based on field availability and as agreed to by both coaches, then confirmed with the League Director or President		
Rescheduling Games When Shorthanded	Teams are expected to play games by calling up/borrowing players if they have 7 or more players. If a team is expected to have 6 or less players available they have the option of playing the game with callups or appealing to the League Director or President to request that the game be rescheduled. <i>NOTE: Only the number of players will be considered when rescheduling. Availability of pitchers or catchers will have no bearing on whether a game may be rescheduled.</i>		
Thunder/Lightning	----- 30 minutes stoppage for first sighting/hearing----- 30 minutes added for each additional sighting/hearing
