



RECYCLING

As part of an ongoing effort, not only to enhance our community, but to preserve the environment, Oak Hill actively participates in recycling programs. We hope that all of our residents will welcome the opportunity to contribute to the cause it represents. The most convenient part about our program is that all of the materials to be recycled may be placed in the same container, except for newspapers.

Materials to be recycled are:

1. **CANS** (aluminum or bi-metallic, food & beverage)
2. **GLASS** (clear or colored, lids removed)
3. **PLASTIC** (soda, juice bottles, shampoo, etc.)
4. **PAPER** (newspapers, magazines, circulars & phonebooks)

It is NOT necessary to remove labels; however, we ask that you rinse out all containers before recycling them. Also, please remove lids from glass containers.

NO AEROSOL CANS OR CARDBOARD CARTONS ARE TO BE INCLUDED.

Newspapers and the like **MUST** be placed in a paper bag or tied. They cannot be placed in plastic bags as it will contaminate the container. Newspapers are to be placed in the trash room in the Terrace buildings or in the trash enclosures of the Estates on **Tuesday** evening for early Wednesday morning pick up. All other recyclables should be placed in the designated containers located in the trash rooms outside the rear entrance of each Terrace building or in the trash enclosures in the Estates.

One of the problems we have been experiencing is the contamination of the recycling cans. Please be sure to put the recyclables in the cans marked **“Co-Mingled”**.
