Confession of Sins

We have not obeyed you completely and so have broken your Holy Law. Grant us forgiveness, for the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Create in us a clean heart, that we might serve you in righteousness and holiness.

First Lesson Isaiah 63:7-14 **7** I will recount the steadfast love of the LORD, the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD has granted us, and the great goodness to the house of Israel that he has granted them according to his compassion, according to the abundance of his steadfast love.**8** For he said, "Surely they are my people, children who will not deal falsely." And he became their Savior.**9** In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them; in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.**10** But they rebelled and grieved his Holy Spirit; therefore he turned to be their enemy, and himself fought against them.**11** Then he remembered the days of old, of Moses and his people. Where is he who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of his flock? Where is he who put in the midst of them his Holy Spirit,**12** who caused his glorious arm to go at the right hand of Moses, who divided the waters before them to make for himself an everlasting name,**13** who led them through the depths? Like a horse in the desert, they did not

stumble.**14** Like livestock that go down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD gave them rest. So you led your people, to make for yourself a glorious name.

Second Lesson Colossians 3:1-11 **1** If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.**2** Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.**3** For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.**4** When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.**5** Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.**6** On account of these the wrath of God is coming.**7** In these you too once walked, when you were living in them.**8** But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.**9** Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices **10** and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.**11** Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all.

Gospel John 21:15-19 **15** When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs."**16** He said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Tend my sheep."**17** He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" and he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep."**18** Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go."**19** (This he said to show by what kind of death he was to glorify God.) And after saying this he said to him, "Follow me."
