

WILLIAM ARTHUR RUPPRECHT

1940 - 1986

William A. Rupprecht age 45, died unexpectedly Friday, Sept. 5, at Huron Memorial Hospital from a blood clot in his lungs.

He was born Sept. 19, 1940 in Saginaw, son of Florence (Krause) Rupprecht and the late Arthur Rupprecht. He preceded him in death in September of 1965.

On August 1, 1964 he was united in marriage to Nancy Lutz in Paris, OH.

Mr. Rupprecht received his Bachelor's Degree in music at Capital University in Columbus, OH. After receiving his Masters at Wayne State University in 1963 he moved to the thumb area. He taught in Kingston two years prior to coming to the Laker School District in 1965 to direct the junior high band and teach junior high English.

He was a member of Cross Lutheran Church serving as choir director. He was also a member of the Pigeon Community Men's Chorus, the Michigan Education Assn. and Phi Mu Alpha National Music Fraternity.

Surviving are his wife, Nancy; his mother, Florence Rupprecht of Saginaw; one sister, Mrs. Kenneth (Nancy) Dean of Farmington Hills; Nancy's parents, Jay and Fern Lutz; her brother, Jay Lutz Jr.; two sisters, Mrs. Lerane (Charlene) Grimminger all of Louisville, OH and Joy Lutz of Elkton. Also several neices and nephews.

Funeral services will be conducted 1:00 PM Wednesday, Sept. 10, at Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon. Pastor Raymond Orth will officiate with burial in the church cemetery.
