We will continue our tradition as we count up to our 100th anniversary by opening our 97th Season with Haydn's Symphony No. 97. Haydn was composing Symphony No. 97 when he learned of the death in Vienna of his 35-year-old student and friend, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. Haydn had attended a rehearsal of Mozart's opera, Cosi Fan Tutte, before he left for London and musicologist believe that the opening bars of Symphony No. 97, a direct quotation from the climax of the opera, honor Mozaart.
