

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Quilt Exhibit is open to all. An entry fee of \$5.00 (non-refundable) is required for each entry to be judged.
2. Quilts previously entered in the RPQG quilt shows are not eligible for competition.
3. Classes for judging and their criteria are listed on the reverse side. Please read carefully to determine the right class for each entry.
4. A 4" deep hanging sleeve is required for all quilt entries.
5. All entries must be clean and in good condition. No quilt made from commercially quilted fabric will be accepted.
6. All quilts MUST hang in the Coliseum Exhibit Room for the duration of the show. No exhibitor will be permitted to set up, remove or rearrange the exhibit.
7. Each entry form must be accompanied by a photograph of the entry.
8. The Quilt Show reserves the right to accept or refuse an entry.
9. Exhibitors agree to allow photographs of their entry to be used in any publicity about the Quilt Exhibit and/or the Rockbridge Regional Fair.




TO ENTER

1. Entry forms are available through the Rockbridge Pieceworks Quilt Guild (www.rpqg.org) or from Carol Schoner (cschoner@comcast.net or 107 Colston Place, Lexington, VA 24450.)
2. Entry forms must be received by Monday, August 14, 2017.
3. **Mailed quilts** must be received by Friday, August 25, 2017. They should be mailed to Pam Gatlin, 35 Gilmer Creek, Lexington, VA 24450. Postage paid by the exhibitor; checks for return postage should be made out to the RPQG.
4. **Hand delivered** entries must be brought to the Virginia Horse Center Coliseum Appomattox Mezzanine on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 from 8am to 10am.
5. Each entry must be accompanied with its own covering (pillowcase or cloth bag) clearly labeled with the exhibitor's name/ phone #.
6. A claim check will be issued for each entry at check-in at the above show location and must be presented to receive the entry after the show.
7. The title of each entry must remain the same from the time it is presented on the entry form to the end of the show.

RELEASE PROCEDURES

1. Quilts will be returned to exhibitors at the show location between 12:30pm and 1:30pm on Sunday, September 10, 2017. NO QUILTS WILL BE RELEASED EARLY. No entries will be released without its own entry claim check.
2. The Quilt Show Committee is not responsible for entries left after 1:30pm on September 10, 2017, unless prior arrangements are made with the Quilt Show Committee, or they are to be returned by prepaid mail.

PRIZES AND JUDGING

1. 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place plus Honorable Mention may be awarded in each class IF the judge deems this is appropriate. When there are few entries in a class, the judge may decide not to award all places, if they are not merited. Only one 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ribbons will be awarded to each class. Cash awards of \$35 are given to 1st place in each category.
2. The Judge will choose one quilt as the Best in Show, one as Judge's Choice, and one as Best Use of Color*. Show viewers will vote on the Viewer's Choice award. These major awards receive \$35.
3. The Judge will consider the following when evaluating the entry: the appearance, design, complexity and workmanship.
4. The Quilt Show will be closed to the public during judging. The decision of the Judge and the Quilt Show Coordinators is final.
5. The Quilt Show Judge for 2017 is Beverly Fine, an NQA Certified Judge.

***Best Use of Color** award and **Class 10 Wearables** award are paid for by **The Quiltery**.

CLASSES FOR QUILT ENTRIES (Circle one class for each entry)

Class 1 - Hand Quilted - Large Quilts Perimeter is 290 inches or more: Includes pieced, appliqued, or whole-cloth quilts.

Class 2 - Hand Quilted Midsize and Small quilts Perimeter less than 290 inches and is not a miniature; includes pieced, appliqued, or whole-cloth quilts.

Class 3 - Machine Quilted - Large Quilts Perimeter 290 inches or more: Pieced or appliqued; machine quilted using domestic machine or long-arm sewing machine.

Class 4 - Machine Quilted - Midsize Quilts Perimeter is 193 to 289 inches; pieced or appliqued; machine quilted using domestic machine or long arm.

Class 5 - Machine Quilted - Small Quilts Perimeter less than 193 inches and is not a miniature; includes pieced or appliqued; machine quilted using domestic machine or long-arm.

Class 6 - Miniature Quilts Perimeter 96 inches or less, and must be a small scale version of a full size quilt design.

Class 7 - Original Design Quilts Design is significant departure from traditional patterns or sets, **must be original design**, no commercial patterns or kits. Emphasis is on color, line and design. Must consist of 3 layers, quilted through all layers.

Class 8 - Other Techniques Yo-yos, cathedral windows, over-all embroidered or cross-stitched (hand or machine), trapunto, tied-quilted, painted, crayon, and any other non-pieced or non-appliqued work.

Class 9 - Youth Work of one person, under 18 years old.

Class 10 - Wearables* Includes jackets, vests, aprons, scarves, and purses. Item must be quilted

Display (Rockbridge Pieceworkers Quilt Guild only) No entry fee; not judged; no ribbons in this class. These quilts will be displayed only as space allows. Limit one per person.
