

SUPPLY LIST-Machine Quilting With A Walking Foot-Linda Glueckert  
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**For this class you will need the following items:**

- Sewing machine and general sewing supplies
- Extension table
- Quilt top prepared as described below
- 1" wide Blue painters tape
- Contrasting color thread for the geometric quilting design. I like to use a variegated color thread.
- Nylon invisible thread. I like YLI.
- Bobbin thread to coordinate with the top thread. I match the colored quilting thread with the bobbin. For the nylon thread I try to match the top fabric.
- Blue wash out marker

**How To Prepare The Quilt Top...**

Your center panel needs to be cut 15 ½ inches square. (It will finish 15 inches square. ) You may have an inner design of no more that 9 inches, that is centered in this block. This design may be a pre-printed panel, pieced, appliqued, or painted. But it must be NO LARGER THAN 9 inches.

Please add 5 inch border to all 4 sides. To do this cut the following...

2 pieces of border fabric 5 ½ by 15 ½

2 pieces of border fabric 5 ½ by 25 ½

Add the 5 x 15 ½ inch border pieces to the sides of the center piece. Sew the 5 x 25 ½ inch pieces to the top and bottom of the center panel.

Layer your quilt top with batting and backing. Baste by your preferred method (spray baste, pin baste, or thread baste. The easiest to work with will be the spray baste, but any method will work.)
