Baltimore Avenue and is open 5 days a week from 10-12 (not open on Wednesdays and Sundays) Clients include approximately 61 people per day (121 in summer) and includes senior citizens, the homeless, and J-1 students in the summer. Each client can get four free items daily (plus toilet paper and water). There are two microwaves on the premises and clients may sit, eat, and chat. The shelter relies heavily on donations.

Also speaking at the meeting was Mr. Scott Fowler of WorCOA. Scott brought everyone up-to-date on the St. Patrick's Day festivities for those that participate in the parade. Everyone should meet at the Senior Center at 9:30-10:00 AM where there will be Dunkin' Donuts and coffee available. After the parade participants will be invited to have Reuben sandwiches and Potato Soup courtesy of the Greene Turtle.

Scott also brought us up-to-date on the Jazz Dinner to be held on April 6th from 5-7 PM at the Senior Center. Catering will be done by the Decatur Diner. Tickets are limited to 100 and the cost is \$15.00 per person. See Ann for tickets.
