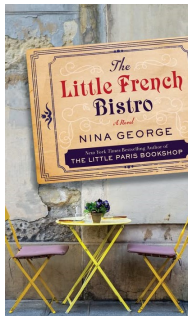
Can you trace your lineage from one of the *Mayflower* Pilgrims?

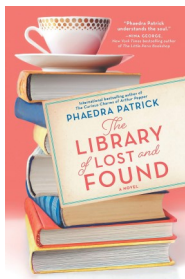

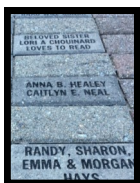

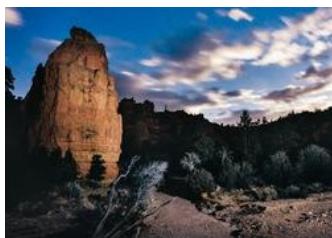
