Misleading Finals

Memphis (-14) beat Florida Atlantic 55-26. The score was 31-26 with just 10 minutes left.

Southern Miss (-4) beat Jacksonville State 42-25. However, Jacksonville State had a 390-377 yard edge. Southern Miss was +3 in turnovers.

Tennessee (-7.5) beat Mississippi State 41-34 in overtime. The Vols were fortunate as they got a 23-yard interception return TD and a 41-yard fumble return TD.

Ole Miss (-2.5) beat LSU 24-19. It was much worse than that as Ole Miss had a 48-254 yard edge. The Rebels fumbled at the goal line in the first half.

Texas A&M (-6.5) beat Auburn 16-10. It was much worse as A&M had a 414-177 yard edge. Auburn was 0-for-12 on third down and their only TD came on a 2-yard "drive" after a long defensive return.

Kennesaw State (-6.5) beat Middle Tennessee 24-16. However, Middle Tennessee had a 440-334 yard edge. Middle was intercepted at the Kennesaw 2-yard line and were also stopped on downs at the Kennesaw 11-yard line.

Louisiana Tech (-4) beat UTEP 30-11. However, UTEP had a 273-232 yard edge. The score was 10-3 with 10 minutes left and LT got a pair of "pick 6's".

Bad Beats

The total in the Oregon/Penn State game was 52. The score was 3-3 in the middle of the third quarter. Penn State got a TD pass with :30 left to make it 17-17 (converted multiple 4th Downs on the drive). Both teams scored TD's in the first OT and the game went over in the second OT with Oregon winning 30-24.

Vanderbilt (-22.5) beat Utah State 55-35. Utah State got a TD in the final minute for the back door cover.

North Texas (-13) beat South Alabama 36-22. South Alabama got a TD and 2-point conversion to make it 28-22 in the middle of the fourth quarter. However, North Texas scored a TD and also converted a 2-point conversion to win by 14.

Injuries/Personnel News

-Iowa State starting cornerbacks Jeremiah Cooper and Jontez Williams have been lost for the season due to injury. Both were All-Big 12 selections.

-Arkansas has fired head coach Sam Pittman. Pittman went 32-34 over six seasons. The Razorbacks are 2-3 this year and just lost 56-13 to Notre Dame. The interim coach will be Bobby Petrino.

-Arkansas has also dismissed DC Travis Williams, DL coach Deke Adams and co-DC Marcus Woodson.

-Oklahoma State has fired DC Todd Grantham after the Cowboys gave up 612 yards to Baylor last Saturday.

-Oklahoma State safeties Dylan Smith and DeAndre Boykins have entered the transfer portal.

-Texas Tech QB Behren Morton will start at Houston this week. He exited the Utah game with a neck injury but had a bye week to recover.

-Iowa QB Mark Gronowski remains questionable for next week's game at Wisconsin. Gronowski exited the Indiana loss with a left knee injury.

-Buffalo CB Charles McCartherens is red-shirting and will enter the transfer portal.

-Buffalo QB Ta'Quan Roberson (ankle) is probable this week.

-TCU WR Eric McAlister (lower body) is hopeful to play this week.

-Charlotte QB Connor Harrell (leg) and RB Henry Rutledge (lower body) are both out for the season.

-West Virginia QB Nicco Marchiol (foot) is expected to miss several weeks.

-Kansas State head coach Chris Klieman is hopeful WR's Jerand Bradley and Jayce Brown will play this week at Baylor.

-North Carolina QB Gio Lopez has returned to practice.

-Baylor WR Louis Brown will redshirt this season.

-UCF QB's Tayven Jackson (shoulder) and Jacurri Brown (shoulder) are both questionable this week.

-Liberty QB Ethan Vasko (upper body) did not play last week.

-Missouri State QB Jacob Clark left the WKU with injury and did not return.

-Kansas RB Daniel Hishaw was not on Week 6 depth chart.

-Kansas TE DeShawn Hanika did not practice on Monday.

-Akron QB Ben Finley was a late scratch on Saturday vs Toledo.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, October 2nd

Sam Houston State 27 NEW MEXICO STATE 25. Sam Houston is 0-4 straight up and 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 10 points per game. They are No. 134 in the country at -2.3 in yards per play. How can you lay points on the road with them? Well, they are off a bye while New Mexico State is off a short week playing their rival. The Aggies are No. 118 in ypp margin despite playing a much weaker schedule.

Friday, October 3rd

SOUTH FLORIDA 40 Charlotte 14. Both teams come in off a bye. Charlotte is No. 124 in yards per play margin at -1.1. They are really banged up on offense down to a backup QB and a backup RB. USF is +1.2 in ypp margin despite playing a Top 10 schedule in terms of difficulty so far. You can see why they're laying 4 TD's here. Our numbers can't get there though.

DELAWARE 30 Western Kentucky 29. This could be a sneaky good game. Delaware has really impressed us after back-to-back outright upsets over Connecticut and FIU. However, now they're playing with expectations vs a perennial winner in WKU. WKU is +0.5 in ypp margin while Delaware is +0.1. However, the Blue Hens have played the more difficult schedule. We lean UNDER at current.

SAN JOSE STATE 28 New Mexico 26. We've upgraded New Mexico more than any team in our power ratings since the start of the season. The Lobos are 3-1 with their only loss at Michigan in a very respectable final. San Jose State almost beat Stanford for a second year in a row but came up 1-point short. At 1-3 the Spartans' backs are against the wall. We lean UNDER at current.

BYU 31 West Virginia 14. West Virginia has gotten blown out the last two weeks. The Mountaineers are really banged up and their starting QB will be out again here. BYU is 4-0 and coming off a close win at Colorado where they had to rally after an early deficit. We're a part of the early UNDER money as BYU's defense ranks No. 4 in scoring and we don't see the WVU offense having much success.

SAN DIEGO STATE 21 Colorado State 16. San Diego State's defense ranks No. 3 in the country allowing just 3.7 yards per play. We thought Sean Lewis was an offensive guy? Colorado State's offense has been horrible ranking No. 131 averaging just 15.3 points per game. They're off a horrible 20-3 home loss to Washington State as a favorite. We lean UNDER.

Saturday, October 4th

APPALACHIAN STATE 26 Oregon State 25. Oregon State comes in 0-5 off a heart-breaking overtime loss to Houston. The Beavers led 24-10 in the middle of the fourth quarter. They rank No. 130 in yards per play margin at -1.8 but have played a Top 5 schedule in terms of difficulty. Appalachian State is off a blowout loss at Boise State. Tough trusting either team right now.

NAVY 31 Air Force 20. Since 2005, the UNDERs are 46-12-2 in service academy games. That's going to be put to the test here. Air Force is 4-0 to the OVER this year by an average of 24 points per game. Their defense is allowing 7.4 yards per play (No. 135). On the bright side, their offense is averaging 7.1 yards per play (No. 18). Navy's offense is even better averaging 7.4 ypp (No. 10). We bet UNDER on the open but are passing at current.

OLD DOMINION 35 Coastal Carolina 17. Coastal is coming in off a bye. Their offense finally put up some points in the upset win over South Alabama but it was with less than 300 yards of offense. ODU has been very impressive this year with a No. 8 ypp margin (+2.9). Their 13-point loss at Indiana looks better and better. Their offense ranks No. 6 in ypp. Can't lay the current number though.

GEORGIA 36 Kentucky 15. Kirby Smart is on a 0-7 ATS run laying 20 or more vs SEC opponents. Will the Bulldogs play inspired after their 33-game home winning streak came to an end last Saturday? Or will it be a sleepy Noon kickoff atmosphere. Might not matter considering Kentucky might be the worst team in the SEC. The Wildcats are off a 22-point loss to South Carolina (Gamecocks did score two defensive TD's). We haven't bet the game.

Utsa 31 TEMPLE 24. Both teams come in off a bye. Temple has certainly exceeded expectations so far (+6 points in our power ratings) while UTSA has been a bit of a disappointment. UTSA has been better in ypp margin and has played a tougher schedule but that's why they're laying a TD on the road. Pass.

Kansas 29 CENTRAL FLORIDA 25. UCF is coming off their first loss of the season. They are banged up at QB and it will be interesting if Tayven Jackson can go here. If he can't, it's tough seeing them keep pace with a Kansas offense that ranks No. 11 averaging 7.3 yards per play. Kansas is also off a loss and has the coaching edge. Pass.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

CINCINNATI 28 Iowa State 26. One of our favorite bets of the season so far is on Cincinnati here (when they were listed an underdog see page 6). The Bearcats are much better in yards per play margin (+2.5 vs +1.0) and the two teams have played similar strength of schedules. Iowa State is down their two starting CB's for the season. Cincy should be getting healthier and are off a big upset win over Kansas. Their offense ranks No. 3 in the country averaging 8.3 yards per play.

LOUISVILLE 35 Virginia 27. You have to be impressed with Virginia so far this season. Their offense ranks No. 5 in the country averaging 540 ypg. However, this is a really tough spot for them. They're coming off arguably their biggest win in 20 years. We're not big fans of the QB or the head coach. Louisville is 4-0 and rallied from 17 down last week. They should be healthier at the skill positions this week.

Washington 30 MARYLAND 23. Not a great spot for Washington here traveling across the country after playing their rival Washington State and Ohio State the last two weeks. They played Ohio State a little tougher than the 24-6 final indicated but are also banged up. Maryland is 4-0 and coming off a bye. We think they are a fraudulent team though as they have played a very weak schedule. Lean UW.

MICHIGAN 31 Wisconsin 14. Both teams come in off a bye. There was a big time difference in momentum going into the bye as Michigan is coming off their best performance of the season winning at Nebraska. Meanwhile, Wisconsin got upset at home 27-10 as a double-digit home favorite to Maryland. Will Luke Fickell make it to next season? The Badgers will be underdogs in every game the rest of the season, Lean OVER. We think the Michigan offense is ascending.

Clemson 30 NORTH CAROLINA 15. Clemson is 0-4 ATS this season failing to cover by 17 points per game. It's safe to say they have been the most disappointing team in the country so far. However, North Carolina has been non-competitive vs the two Power 4 programs they've played (TCU and UCF). If Clemson has their heads on straight, they should destroy the Tar Heels. Big "if" though.

OHIO STATE 34 Minnesota 11. There's not much chatter around the defending national champs which should scare the rest of CFB. The Bucks defense ranks No. 1 in the country allowing 5.5 points per game. It was another impressive performance last week holding a talented Washington offense to 6 points. QB Sayin has been the most accurate passer in CFB. What are their weaknesses? Will RB Darius Taylor return for Minny? If not, they are too one-dimensional to keep up.

PITTSBURGH 33 Boston College 28. Both teams come in off tough conference losses and their bowl hopes are already in danger thanks to a combined 0-4 record in close games. Pittsburgh has been the better team in the stats but BC has played the tougher schedule. We bet the OVER on Sunday and would still lean that way.

VIRGINIA TECH 28 Wake Forest 22. Virginia Tech comes in off by far their best performance of the season as they upset NC State as 10-point underdogs. That's back-to-back wins now for interim Philip Montgomery. They're facing a Wake Forest team that deserved to upset Georgia Tech last week. A blatant offside on Georgia Tech that would have ended the game was not called. VT has played the much tougher schedule but Wake has a better ypp margin and is the better running team. We bet VT -3.5. We can't recommend them at -7.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 26 Akron 18. Akron QB Ben Finley was a late scratch last week and the Zips were crushed by Toledo 45-3. As of press time Wednesday afternoon, we're not sure if he will play here. If he doesn't go, Akron has the worst offense by far in the country. Central is off a nice 24-13 win over rival Eastern. Lean UNDER.

Ohio 35 BALL STATE 19. The market hated the Ohio last week as the Bobcats closed only 7.5-point home favorites vs Bowling Green. Market was wrong as Ohio won and covered 35-20. Ohio is banged up on defense and are playing a Ball State team off a bye. Problem is the Cardinals rank No. 132 getting outgained by 158 ypg. We lean OVER.

BUFFALO 30 Eastern Michigan 21. A lot of money coming in on Buffalo and the OVER here. The Bulls will see the return of QB Roberson who has missed the last two games. We don't think much of him. However, the EMU defense ranks No. 134 allowing 7.3 yards per play.

Western Michigan 30 MASSACHUSETTS 17. Western is starting to figure some things out. They have covered 4 out of 5 games this season. They followed up the upset of Toledo by hammering Rhode Island 47-14. Keep in mind, WMU was only a 7.5-point favorite in the game. Meanwhile, UMass is 0-4 while ranking No. 135 in ypp margin (-2.4). Lots of early groups on Western.

James Madison 36 GEORGIA STATE 17. James Madison is 4-0 ATS this season covering their games by 7.6 points per game. Georgia State is 0-4 ATS this season failing to cover their games by 16.8 points per game. Easy to see why the early money is on JMU.

NORTHWESTERN 27 UL-Monroe 16. This is not the preferred spot for Northwestern laying double-digits. Both teams run very slow tempo (ULM No. 128 in plays per minute, Northwestern No. 129). ULM is the better run team but has played a much weaker schedule. We laid -9.5 on the open but it was just a numbers play.

MEMPHIS 37 Tulsa 19. Memphis had a misleading blowout win over FAU last week. They led 31-26 with 10 minutes left..the Tigers won 55-26. That's two weeks in a row where the final was better than the gameflow and box. We think that could make them a little overrated here against a Tulsa team that's been better than expected.

TROY 24 South Alabama 23. We like South Alabama here but need the "+3". The Jags are better in ypp margin (-0.1 vs -0.8) despite playing a similar strength of schedule. Troy is off a bye but still playing with a backup QB. USA backers got a bad beat last week when North Texas went and converted a 2-pointer in the final 2 minutes.

NEBRASKA 30 Michigan State 20. We're not buying this Nebraska team like some folks in the market. They've been dominated at the line of scrimmage by Cincinnati and Michigan getting out-rushed 488-153 in those two games. Both teams are off a bye. We think it benefits Michigan State more since they were more banged up heading into it. Keep an eye on the weather. 20 mph wind is fore casted.

MIAMI, OH 21 Northern Illinois 17. The Northern Illinois offense is one of the worst units in football right now. They rank dead last in scoring at 10.3 ppg and rank 2nd to last in yards per play and total offense. Miami, Ohio finally got their first win last week shutting out Lindenwood. We bet Miami on the openers but can't lay the current 5.

ARIZONA 37 Oklahoma State 17. Oklahoma State played their first game without Mike Gundy as head coach in more than two decades last week. It was their first cover of the season as they only trailed Baylor 35-27 entering the fourth quarter. They fired DC Grantham though after the game and this is a small staff. Arizona got a ton of money in the market last week. It was dead wrong. They're getting a ton of money here. We hope it's right because we bet them on Sunday.

CALIFORNIA 28 Duke 27. This is going to be a tough game on Duke. It's their 5th straight game with a point spread priced at 4 or less (meaning competitively matched games). It's a very long trip and a late start (10:30pm ET). Cal got a big upset win at Boston College after suffering an upset loss the week prior. They beat Minnesota at home catching a FG in a late start a few weeks ago. This feels similar.

Penn State 37 UCLA 11. James Franklin is going to get it done. The Nittany Lions had everything going for them last Saturday. Considering their first 3 games they were 40-points favorites, they could have prepped all off-season for Oregon. The Ducks were the younger team on the road. Early in the fourth Oregon led 17-3 and it was worse than that. Kudos to Penn State for getting it going late but that was one hell of a gut punch. UCLA was down 17-0 last week and but got the cover vs Northwestern. It all depends on Penn State's frame of mind.

Texas 24 FLORIDA 17. Both teams come in off a bye. Texas has a huge edge in their No. 1 defense (in yards per play) vs Florida's No. 118 offense. However, the matchup we want to see is Arch Manning vs an underrated Florida defense. If Florida is still motivated after the 1-3 start, this could be interesting. The UNDER has been blasted.

Miami, FL 30 FLORIDA STATE 27. This game lost a little luster after Florida State got upset in double overtime at Virginia on Friday. Still, it's one of the bigger games in this rivalry in the last 20 years. Miami comes in off the bye. The Hurricanes look like maybe the best team in the country if you focus solely at the line of scrimmage. That will get tested here vs a FSU offense that ranks No. 1 in the country averaging 600 yards per game and 53 points per game. FSU will have the coaching edge. We're expecting tight one. Wide Right 4?

Illinois 32 PURDUE 22. We thought we would be liking Purdue here but the market is all over this. The Boilers are much improved this year under Barry Odom and come in off a bye. They're catching Illinois playing a 6th straight week and off a thrilling win over USC. Need "+10" or more to recommend a decent bet though. Lean UNDER.

ALABAMA 34 Vanderbilt 21. This is one of our bigger power ratings disparities this week. It's not that we don't like Vanderbilt. We've upgraded them 6 points and they're in our Top 20 of our ratings. We just think if Alabama has their heads on straight after the upset win over Georgia, they should be laying close to 14 here. Losing to Vanderbilt last year in the same situation should have their full attention.

RICE 28 Florida Atlantic 25. FAU only trailed Memphis 31-26 in the fourth quarter last week before imploding. Turnovers (-8 margin) have been their undoing this season. Despite being a dog, they do have a better ypp margin and have played the tougher schedule. That is one of our favorite systems to play on the last few years.

Texas Tech 31 HOUSTON 20. Texas Tech comes in off the bye after an impressive road upset over Utah. The bye week allowed QB Behren Morton to get healthy and he will start here. Houston was very fortunate to escape Corvallis with a win last week. They trailed 24-10 in the middle of the fourth quarter but won in OT. We didn't bet side or total here.

TCU 34 Colorado 20. TCU blew a 17-point lead last week at Arizona State. The Sun Devils did have a 500-271 yard edge in the game though. A tough year for Coach Prime's Buffaloes so far and it will only get tougher. You have to think Sonny Dykes hasn't forgot about losing to Colorado in Coach Prime's debut a couple years ago. If they get a chance to pour it on, they will. We lean UNDER.

BAYLOR 32 Kansas State 27. Our power ratings lean Baylor here. However, we got a sneaky suspicion that Kansas State may have turned their season around last week. Coming of the bye, they got the win and cover vs UCF. More importantly, RB Edwards looked healthy for the first time this season and ran for 166 yards. He'll have opportunities for success vs a Baylor defense that ranks No. 105 in scoring.

Army 34 UAB 24. UAB is coming off a bye and has already faced the option earlier this season vs Navy (lost 38-24 as 20.5-point road underdogs). Their defense did allow 295 yards rushing in that game. They're getting a desperate 1-3 Army team that has a pair of OT losses. Our ratings say Army is the play here.

SMU 36 Syracuse 21. It's really a one-factor handicap here. How much do you continue to downgrade Syracuse without their starting QB? We thought we had a solid handle on it last week and then Syracuse went out and lost 38-3 at home to Duke. SMU has stunk this year. They are 0-4 ATS and have failed to cover by 10.8 points per game. Yet, the market continues to bet them here.

CONNECTICUT 31 FIU 23. FIU comes in off a bye. They had a disappointing home loss to Delaware prior to it. UConn is off a pair of wins vs MAC teams and we weren't overly impressed in either performance (only beat Ball State by 6 and faced a backup Buffalo QB). We bet FIU on the openers but our numbers are close to the current market.

NOTRE DAME 41 Boise State 24. Notre Dame's 56-13 win over Arkansas last week as a 5-point favorite was one of the most impressive of the season. It also inflated this line a bit as the look-ahead had this line under 17 points last week (we know look-aheads are an ill-liquid market). Since the loss to USF, Boise has rebounded with 3 straight wins and covers. They almost beat Oregon on the road and "only" lost by 17 to Penn State last year. This is their biggest underdog role since 1999. We have bet them this week and our ratings like them.

OKLAHOMA 51 Kent State 6. The main handicap here is seeing how Michael Hawkins will do for Oklahoma with John Mateer out for a few more weeks. He's obviously not going to get tested much here vs a Kent State team that ranks dead last in ypp margin (-2.7) and ypp margin (-251). Texas is on deck, so how long does Hawkins play? Lean OVER.

TEXAS A&M 36 Mississippi State 21. Mississippi State has been impressive this season. They did lose in OT last week vs Tennessee (but did cover) despite the fact the Vols had a pair of defensive TD's. The problem is they are banged up at the line of scrimmage especially at OT and struggled with Tennessee's pass rush. Could be more of the same here vs an A&M front that just got 7 sacks vs Auburn.

Unlv 27 WYOMING 24. We're not buying this UNLV team. They are 4-0 this season but none of their opponents has a win over an FBS team so far this season. They are coming off another bye (this is only their 2nd game played since September 7th). Check the weather forecast as it's supposed to be windy, wet and 50 degrees. We wouldn't be surprised if Wyoming pulled the upset.

Texas State 35 ARKANSAS STATE 24. Texas State comes in off a bye. They have been impressive this year with a +0.8 ypp margin. The same can't be said for Arkansas State who is 1-4 on the seasons and rank No. 133 with a -2.2 yards per play margin. This is the type of game Texas State struggled with last year as they suffered five outright upset losses. Our ratings like Arkansas State and the UNDER.

FRESNO STATE 30 Nevada 16. Both teams come in off a bye. We've been impressed with Fresno State under first-year coach Matt Entz. Now they're playing with a bit of expectations. Nevada deserved the cover in their last game at Western Kentucky. Both teams run a slower tempo and prefer the run. We don't see a ton of value.

What will possibly do them in here is an injury report that saw QB Purdy and WR's Jennings and Pearsall not practicing on Tuesday. That's on top of all the other injuries they have. On the other side, one week after the Rams had an unfortunate loss to the Eagles, they got a fortunate win over the Colts getting a 88-yard TD pass with 1:33 left to play. Tough laying this kind of number though when Shanahan has a 10-6 record vs McVay. UNDER maybe the play for us. As we're typing this on Wednesday morning, a sharp group did lay 6.5 with the Rams.

Sunday, October 5th

† **Minnesota 20 Cleveland 16.** @Tottenham Hotspur Stadium in London, England. The Vikings are playing back-to-back weeks overseas. Last week did not go so well as they trailed Pittsburgh 24-6 before rallying to make the final respectable. QB Wentz threw for 350 yards but also two crucial interceptions. Meanwhile, turnovers did the Browns in again as three of them led to 17 Detroit points on just 41 yards of total offense for the Lions on those three drives. It's tough trusting either QB and we do feel the very low total is justified.

Miami 24 CAROLINA 22. After the Dolphins got their first win of the season, the market seems to love them here as they have flipped from dogs to favorites in the last 24 hours. That's despite the fact WR Hill dislocated his knee on MNF. It's probably more of a play against the hapless Panthers who were crushed by the Patriots on Sunday. A week after losing the yardage battle in a 30-0 win, Carolina actually had the yardage edge in a 42-13 loss. We're not as optimistic on the Dolphins as our cohorts but we want nothing to do with the Panthers.

Dallas 26 N.Y. JETS 24. The Cowboys come in off the wild 40-40 tie with Green Bay on SNF. Amazingly, it is the first tie for the Cowboys in a game since 1969 and it was the 2nd highest scoring tie in NFL history. Meanwhile the Jets come in off the loss at Miami on MNF. Despite their 0-4 record, Jets actually have a better yards per play margin (-0.1 vs -0.5) than the Cowboys. We're not wild about either team or either rookie head coach. We could see the Jets in a teaser but the Cowboys offense should have success vs their bad defense.

INDIANAPOLIS 27 Las Vegas 22. The Colts led the Rams 20-13 but fell 27-20 after the Rams got a 88-yard TD pass with 1:33 left. Also key was Colts WR Mitchell inexcusably fumbling at the goal line in the second half. The Colts are No. 3 in yards per play margin at +1.1 and they've definitely been one of the surprises in the league so far as they were projected to have a losing season. On the other side, the Raiders had a 6.9-4.2 yards per play edge vs the Bears but lost by one thanks to a blocked FG and four turnovers. While we think Indy is much improved, they are now playing with expectations. We like the Raiders to cover.

PHILADELPHIA 23 Denver 21. The defending Super Bowl champs are 4-0 but their box scores are a mess. The Eagles are -1.2 in yards per play ranking No. 28. Last week their offense had minus-1 yard in the second half. Yes, you read that right...MINUS-ONE YARD in an entire half of football. The Eagles also got another non-offensive TD this time via a blocked punt. The Broncos are traveling across the country on a short week after crushing the Bengals on MNF. Denver ranks No. 8 with a +0.9 yards per play margin and are a bit unfortunate to be 2-2. We wouldn't be surprised if Denver pulled the upset. Keep an eye on the statuses of Eagles OL Johnson and DL Carter who were banged up last week.

NEW ORLEANS 22 N.Y. Giants 19. This is one of the worst matchups in the league this season. You have a rookie QB in Jaxson Dart making his first road start. Yes, Dart led the upset win over the Chargers last week. Yes, he ran for 54 yards. However, he only threw for 111 and WR Nabers is out with a torn ACL. Two Chargers turnovers led to 10 Giants' points on just two yards of offense. On the other side, the Saints are 0-4 on the season but we don't think they're horrible...yet. They played the Bills closer than the final last week. We like the Saints here.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

BALTIMORE 21 Houston 20. One of the bigger line moves we've ever seen. The look-ahead line had Baltimore -9.5 and now they find themselves 1.5-point home underdogs. Is Lamar Jackson (hamstring out a few weeks) worth 11 points compared to Cooper Rush? No, but keep in mind the Ravens also lost LT Ronnie Stanley and were playing without SEVEN defensive starters by the end of the Kansas City game last week. Just a brutal way to start the season for one of the best teams. Houston finally picked themselves off the mat last week in a 26-0 win over Tennessee. Something has to give with the total as Baltimore games are 4-0 to the OVER while Houston games are 4-0 to the UNDER. Not sure we'll be involved here but we don't expect the Ravens to lay down.

ARIZONA 24 Tennessee 17. Arizona has extra time to prep after losing at home to the Seahawks last Thursday. Their fourth quarter rally came up just short as they lost back-to-back games on the final play of regulation for the first time since at least 1988. There are no 4Q rallies in Tennessee games this year. They stink as they are dead last in the NFL at -2.2 yards per play. Last week, the Titans lost to 0-3 Houston 26-0. QB Ward was 10 of 26 for 108 yards. Head coach Brian Callahan shouldn't be a head coach as he fell to 3-18. We're not wild about laying more than a TD with Kyler Murray but we do think the Cards are a solid teaser option.

SEATTLE 25 Tampa Bay 20. We think the Seahawks should be getting a little more respect in the markets. They are No. 2 in the NFL in yards per play margin at +1.2. They are No. 1 in the updated DVOA (advanced stat) metrics. They have won and covered three straight and we're big fans of their young staff. Tampa comes in off their first loss of the season. They did hold the Eagles to MINUS-1 yard in the second half. Obviously, we think they are a bit fortunate this year having won their first three games in the final minute. We like the Seahawks here.

Detroit 29 CINCINNATI 18. The Lions come in off the blowout win over the Browns and should expect another blowout win over an Ohio team here. Do note the Lions did get 17 points on just 41 yards of offense after three Cleveland turnovers. They're playing a Cincinnati offense that set the game of football back a couple generations last Monday. After the Bengals scored a FG on their first possession, they did not cross midfield again! This is a bad roster further exposed without QB Burrow. Detroit's offense should be able to do whatever they want vs a weak Cincinnati defense.

LA. CHARGERS 26 Washington 22. The Chargers are coming off their first loss of the season. It was very misleading as they had a 6.0-3.8 yards per play edge vs the lowly Giants. A pair of Chargers' turnovers turned into 10 Giants' points on just two yards of offense. More damaging was the loss of OT Joe Alt who will be out several weeks. The Commanders played their second straight game without QB Daniels last week. They fell at Atlanta. The expectation is that Daniels should return here. We lean with the Chargers here but could be talked into the OVER if Daniels is 100%.

BUFFALO 28 New England 21. Both teams have played weak schedules so far. Buffalo is 4-0 but they haven't been dominant the last two weeks vs Miami and New Orleans. Despite the 4-0 record and vs a weak schedule, Buffalo is only No. 8 in ypp margin at +0.9. Both games were close until the Bills pulled away late. New England is off a "feel good" blowout win over the hapless Panthers. We're not wild about anything here. A teaser on the Bills seems almost too easy.

Monday, October 6th

Kansas City 25 JACKSONVILLE 23. Kansas City has gotten wins and covers the last two weeks to get to .500. Obviously, they benefited from Baltimore QB Lamar Jackson getting hurt and the Ravens being down seven defensive starters by the end of the game. The Jags come in off one of their bigger regular season wins in recent memory. They did benefit from a +4 turnover margin in the game. The Jags are better in yards per play margin at +0.2 vs KC's +0.0. It should be one of Jacksonville's better home atmosphere's in recent memory. We lean with them getting the hook.

Bye: Atlanta, Chicago, Green Bay at Pittsburgh.
