On Your Toes Dance Studio Recreational Dance

1. What is the difference in recreational and competitive dance?

Recreational

Students who are taking only one or two classes a week in any dance discipline. Students will study a tap/jazz combination class that lasts for 45 minutes each week. Performing is limited to the year-end show. All Gymnastics classes are also Recreational.

Competitive

An auditioned group of Students taking a minimum of three classes a week. Competitive students will compete at 3-4 competitions, and may be asked to perform at community events, In addition to the spring recital.

2. What classes do you offer for recreational dancers ages 2-5?

Preschool Classes

No dance experience needed. This class is for students who are interested in learning what dance is all about. Basic technique and combinations will be taught creating a solid foundation for all forms of dance. We focus on motor skills, and basic fundamentals of dance. Educational games and activities are incorporated into the class.

3. What classes are available for recreational dancers ages 6 and up?

Recreational Tap and Jazz Combination Class

Tap and Jazz Combination Class: This is the most popular recreational class that we offer at On Your Toes. This class will educate dancers in two areas of dance which will prepare them for show choir, dance team, cheerleading, and other activities. After one year in this class, they will have been exposed to all the basic fundamentals, and may audition in order to transition to a competitive level team.

HIP HOP

Recreational Hip Hop: - (Ages 10 and up) This class will introduce a fun way to learn a new style of age appropriate hip hop dancing. Come and learn the funky moves you see in music videos.

4. What is the dress code for recreational classes?

Combination Classes Ages 2 - 9

- Any style or color leotard (Tights or Socks Recommended)
- Pink Ballet Shoes
- Black Tap Shoes

Combination Classes Ages 10 and Up

- Any style or color leotard and tights
- Black Jazz Shoes
- Black Tap Shoes

Leaps and Turns, Fundamentals of Dance Team, and Turns for Dancers

- Dancers should wear a sports bra or leotard and dance shorts
- Half Shoes or Jazz Shoes

Tumbling

- No Shoes
- Gym Leotard, fitted top, or sports bra and shorts
- Tee Shirts should be tucked in
- Hair Pulled Away from Face (Ponytail)

Hip Hop Classes

- Any Dance Attire
- Converse Style Shoes/Athletic Shoes

5. How much is this going to cost?

On Your Toes charges a yearly \$25 registration fee. You will pay \$45.00 monthly for the first class that you take, \$30.00 monthly for the second class, and \$25 each additional class added to the schedule. Example – (Tap and Jazz combination class - \$45.00 – adding on hip hop \$30.00) Total \$75.00.

Mini Classes are also available for 2-3 year olds. These are 30 minutes in length, and \$35.00 for one, or \$60.00 for dance and gymnastics.

Family Discounts - \$5.00 monthly discount on the second child from the same family, \$10.00 monthly discount on the third child from the same family.

Late Fees - Late fees will be enforced unless payment arrangements are previously made. Payments are due on the first of each month, and a \$10.00 late fee will be applied on the 15th of each month.

Hold Payment - The studio will gladly hold a check for a maximum of 14 days. You must place payment in an envelope with "HOLD PAYMENT" on the front of the envelope with the cleared date.

Returned Checks - There will be a \$35.00 fee on all returned checks.

6. How are recreational dancers placed in a class?

When new dancers join On Your Toes, they typically begin with their age group and move to the appropriate class as they progress.

7. How much are costumes and performance fees?

Costume Fees (Non Refundable)

- \$65.00 Per Costume (2 Costumes per dancer)

Recital Fees (Non Refundable)

- \$65.00 Per Dancer

Payment Schedule

8. What happens if my dancer decides dance isn't for him/her?

No problem! I certainly understand that every child looks for the creative outlet that best suits them. I will need an e mail indicating that you would like to withdraw from the studio. Your account will be billed until your written request is received.

Since tuition is paid on a monthly basis, there are no "contracts" to be signed. However, there are no refunds once a month of tuition has been paid.

9. What are the observation policies?

All of our Recreational classes are open for observation, however we are asking that only one adult observer comes in the building per dancer in order to keep from overcrowding the lobby.
