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#### Power washing

Power washing of the town homes and Condos was completed in August. There has been some damage to some of the vents on the townhomes. Most of these vents were brittle and broke easily under the pressure of the water.

Any damage will be taken care of as soon as possible. Cert Pro is the contractor. Single Family homes power washing as well as deck or patio power washing for SFH or Townhomes that signed up and paid to have the extra work done, should be complete by now. The Board will be discussing if we should set a more frequent schedule in the future. We will review the cost and how much needs to be allocated to deferred maintenance going forward.

#### Crack sealing repair completed

All the cracks are sealed and <u>for those that signed up</u> to have their drives sealed will have that work begin in September. Thank you for working with us by moving your cars to make this work done as efficient as possible. The Board will be reviewing the next major step of road repair which is the capital item of milling and paving all the streets. We still have a few years to go on the item.

#### **Board Elections ... November 11, 2020**

Board Elections will be held at the November 11, 2020 at



the Annual meeting. At the moment, it appears that we will need to vote by ballot that will be distributed and returned. Please keep in mind that we require a quorum to validate the election by ballot. As you exercise your right and duty to vote in the upcoming election on Nov. 3rd, it is important that you

have a say in the choice of the makeup of the Board that represents you and acts on your behalf. Two seats are up this year. Nancy will be distributing information as to how the process works very soon. By the way, for the national election you need to request a ballot early. Check with the Hillsborough Municipality for details.

In addition to the election, the 2021 budget will be presented. The Board and Nancy will be working on a Zoom meeting for the Annual meeting and will send out the notice once we complete the process.
