The Jr. Committee will be limited to a maximum of 10 members; however, the Livestock Committee will make selections at their discretion based on application quality and merit and may select less than 10 qualified candidates to form the Jr. Committee.

Must be willing to help with any and all aspects of the VV Fair and preparation leading up to it

Must demonstrate leadership skills, set a good example in and out of the show ring, and be willing to learn new things

Must pay a \$5 annual membership fee
