

# School Supply List for 2025/2026

**\* Some General Notes:** Please do not send supplies that are toys. All students in grades 3-8 will receive a new Bible as a gift from Cross Lutheran Church in the fall.

## **Grades DK & K**

- Book bag that fits in locker (no toddler sizes)
- 1 canister of Play-Dough (labeled with name)
- Well-fitting shoes that your child can tie or fasten themselves (tying several sets of shoes several times a day is time consuming). Please keep in mind the active nature of young children. Safety is most important.
- Headphones for computer use (no ear buds or wireless headphones)
- 1 Pink block eraser (labeled with name)
- 1 1.5 inch 3 ring binder with clear pocket on front
- Closable Water bottle (non-disposable)
- Blanket 3' x 4' or smaller (optional for rest time)
- 1 box Clorox Wipes
- 1 box tissues
- 1 package coffee filters

## **Grades 1 & 2**

- Book bag that fits in locker
- Headphones or ear buds for computer use
- Well-fitting shoes that your child can tie or fasten themselves (tying several sets of shoes several times a day is time consuming). Please keep in mind the active nature of young children. Safety is most important.
- 1 Sturdy Plastic Pocket Folder
- 1 Pink block eraser
- 2 Elmer's Glue sticks
- 1 Composition book, wide-rule
- Closable Water bottle (non-disposable)
- 2 boxes of tissues

## **Grades 3 & 4**

- 24 Pack Crayola Crayons
- 12 Pack Crayola Colored Pencils
- 10 Pack Crayola Markers
- 2 Elmer Glue Sticks
- 1 Pink Block Eraser
- 5 Pencils
- 2 Pens
- Small Sharpener
- Scissors
- Headphones – NOT wireless
- 1 Pack Loose Leaf Wide Ruled Paper for classroom use
- 1 6"x9" plastic container or zipper pouch
- Book bag that fits in locker
- Closable water bottle

## **Grades 5 & 6 Supply List for 2025-2026 School Year**

### **Required Supplies:**

- Faith Alive Student Bible (new students will be provided with one)
- 1-2 packs of No. 2 pencils or mechanical pencils with extra lead
- Hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 pack of highlighters with the colors yellow, green & pink
- 1 pack of block erasers or package of pencil eraser tops
- 1 small pack of glue sticks
- Scissors
- 1 pencil box or zippered pouch
- 1 spiral bound one-subject notebook (no multi-subject notebooks)
- 6 pocket folders that can go in a 3-ringed binder
- 1 1.5 inch 3-ringed binder
- 1 composition notebook (not spiral bound)
- Closable water bottle (not disposable)
- Book bag that fits in locker
- Headphones or earbuds for computer use (NO wireless please)
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- 1-2 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 box/container/bag of snacks to put in the back-up snack box for students who forget to bring a snack to school

# Supply List for Grades 7-8

## Required Supplies:

- ✓ Faith Alive Student Bible (one will be provided for new students)
- ✓ No. 2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- ✓ 1 or 2 colored pens
- ✓ 5 one-subject spiral-bound notebooks (no multi-subject notebooks)
- ✓ At least 5 pocket folders
- ✓ 1 three-ring binder ( $\frac{1}{2}$  inch)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ 1 small pencil box or pouch
- ✓ Headphones or ear buds for computer use
- ✓ 1 box of Tissue
- ✓ Closable, reusable water bottle (non-disposable)
- ✓ Calculator- a scientific calculator (\$10-\$20) is required. Graphing calculators (\$90+) may also be used. Students will be required to have a graphing calculator in high school. If you are considering purchasing a new graphing calculator for your child to use now and in the future, I recommend the TI-84 Plus. **Please do not buy anything by Casio.** If you have questions about calculators, please ask Mr. Faupel before you buy one.

## Do NOT bring:

- × Art supplies (crayons, markers, etc.); these will be provided at school
- × Desktop organizers (they take up too much space and are not necessary)
- × Staplers or tape dispensers (these are available in the classroom)
- × Anything that will be a distraction or is not necessary for school
