

From Pastor Travis's Study

WHY? NOT

Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Grace to you and peace in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

When I was a student at Albright College, I had a friend who was a Philosophy major. We laughed at him quite a bit for this decision in his life, but it was also interesting to hear about the topics that they were discussing in classes. One year during finals he told us that for one of his classes the final consisted of just one word. The final was just one word and one question mark only. That question was "why?". My friend said that there were students, himself included, who filled up numerous test booklets answering this one simple question. Then he said there was one student who answered the question with a question of just two words. This student answered the question with "why not?". I am not sure how this worked out for this student, and I am sure that this story is one that gets told in all philosophy circles and probably has never happened.

These questions of "why" and "why not" are often ones that I think about. Why or why not should I do something? Why or why not should I care about that? Why or why not should I eat that container of Ben and Jerry's Ice-cream? We are often faced with these questions. Why? Why not?

This is the same for us in the church. Why do we exist? Why do we do these things? Why not do something else? Why? Why not?

I have recently read a book entitled <u>Witness Your Why</u> by Jeremy Scott. In this book the question of Why is asked and then it tells us to make the answer to that answer the center of all that we do. Why does the church exist? Jesus calls us in Matthew 28 to go into the world and make disciples. This is also the mission of the United Methodist Church. It is our mission to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. This is our Why. This is what makes us who we are. We are then called to go and to share with others that why.

Often times in the church we get stuck in the What and How of church life. What are we going to do? And, how are we going to do it? I want us to start to think about Why? What is our WHY? Is our WHY at the center of who we are? Why or Why not?

May God Bless you in the days ahead so that you may be a blessing to others.



Leadership Team Report...

The Team is still waiting for the architect to provide the design plan for the Center St. ramp awning. Once we have that, we will proceed with requesting grant monies to help with the installation.

The new landscaping at the Parsonage is scheduled to start during the first week in October. In addition, the same firm will meet with Bethany Leadership on September 27 to discuss plans and costs in connection with managing and improving the landscaping at the church itself.

Several ideas having been tossed around for the location of our church picnic, we settled on the Bethany side yard, and we set the event for 1:00 PM on Sunday, October 15. Further details will emerge shortly.

The Team is looking to establish an updated set of guidelines for the creation, custodianship, and management of funds that are earmarked by donors as memorials. We will build on and modify (as necessary) whatever guidelines have been in force in the past, adding fresh rulings as applicable.

We are waiting for a representative of the Milton Winterfest Committee to sign an agreement for the use of our church when they hold their planned "ugly sweater" party on December 16 (5 to 9 PN). We will request a space-usage deposit from the committee, refundable to the extent not needed,

Bethany is again invited to participate in the "Thanksgiving in a Bag" program that the HandUp Foundations runs annually. So far, we know that the deadline date for contributions will be November 5. Further details, such as a list of suggested food items, will soon be forthcoming.

This year's Angel Tree event is still an option for Bethany to take part in, but there's some doubt as to the wisdom of accepting responsibility for multiple children's wish list tags because of noticeable declines in church member participation in that in recent years. Instead, we will likely focus on helping one selected family in lieu if trying to take care of the lists of several kids.

The Team has voted approval for Bethany to give out candy to roaming children when Milton has its designated Halloween trick-or-treat evening. It was suggested that we try to include tots that the YMCA routinely shepherds around the church area.

Trustees Report

It was a rather quiet month for Trustee related items. Trustee items completed or in process:

- As reported last month, the Leadership Team chose Creative Plantscapes to totally redo the landscaping at the Parsonage. We paid the down payment and are waiting to hear when they plan to start the project. I've notified them that we chose the unlimited guarantee. For the annual fee associated with the unlimited guarantee, they will spring clean the landscaping, edge the beds, and complete any necessary trimming. They also fertilize the plants and spray them to control insects and disease and will replace anything that dies.
- At the last meeting there was also a discussion of the landscaping at the church needing some sprucing up. Creative Plantscapes met with some of the Leadership Team at the church to discuss thoughts and ideas. We are currently waiting to receive their proposal.
- We approved Leezer Commercial Door working on several items related to doors around the church and Parish House. It includes; new weather stripping on the Front Street entrance doors, adjusting the glass handicapped accessible door, installing a closer and adjusting the restroom door in the kitchen, repairing the latch on the Center Street Entrance, and repairing or replacing the panic hardware on the rear exit of the Parish House. They are currently very busy with some large school jobs, but will get us on the schedule as soon as possible.
