Entry fees: \$28.00 per hunter, equitation and jumper class.

\$33.00 for Medal classes

\$35.00 for Hunter Derby and Gambler's Choice

Office Fee: \$15.00 per entry. Non-refundable

Stall Fees: \$125.00 per stall or tack stall.

First bedding is NOT PROVIDED

Stabling is in permanent shed row stalls. Shavings are \$11.00 per bag if pre ordered.

Hay is \$16.00 per bale if pre ordered.

Haul-in Fee: \$20.00 per horse, per day, unless renting a stall.

Non-showing horse: \$100.00 if there are stalls available. Contact Sandi Carlton.

Fox Brush Horse Show Info:

Horses may arrive after 9:00AM on Thursday July 17.

Schooling Open: Thursday: 10 AM – 7 PM.

Friday, Saturday and Sunday: 6:00 AM – 7:30 AM

- Entries close on Tuesday, July 15th. Late entries, if accepted, will be charged a \$25.00 fee
- All riders must have a SIGNED entry on file in the show office before riding or schooling
 in any ring. Entries must have ALL signatures (trainer, adult rider, and parent in the case
 of a child or junior) and be accompanied by a signed blank check made payable to
 "Fox Brush Farm." Back numbers will not be released without a signed open check.
- Stall reservations with a signed, open check, must be received by June 16. No stall refunds will be made after June 30, unless management can sell your stall. You must send a check to Fox Brush Farm in advance of the show to guarantee your stall reservation.
- Payment and non-negotiable checks: Payment is permitted by cash and check only. We cannot accept credit cards at this time. A signed open check must be given to the secretary to cover the cost of the horse show expenses. Checks should be made out to "Fox Brush Farm." A non-negotiable check will be charged a collection fee of \$50.00. Entries may be denied based on prior offenses or may be subject to cash only payment.
- Non-Showing horses:
 - Non-showing horses must have an entry filled out and submitted to the office.
 - Horses on the grounds that are scratched for the entire show will be considered non-showing and charged a non-showing fee of \$100.
- Scratched horses that are scratched prior to arriving at the show grounds and after June 30, will be charged an office fee and stall fee unless management can sell the stall.
- Riding horses on the premises is restricted to the schooling areas and show rings and travel between these areas and the stabling. Horses are to be lunged in the lunging area at the front of the property.
- Headgear: All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets with harness secured, while mounted on the show grounds.
- Medic: An EMT/MFR will be on duty during show days.
- All classes shall follow the USEF or LEHS rules. LEHS rule books are available from the show secretary.
- Prizes for first place. Ribbons to sixth place. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons for LEHS recognized divisions and walk-trot.
- Management reserves the right to divide, cancel or combine classes as entries warrant.

- An order of go will be posted for Medal classes.
- Braiding is optional
- Waterloo insists that ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH at all times
- No stakes or posts are to be placed in the ground.
- ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING in barn areas.
- Fox Brush Farm, its owner, management, employees and staff, along with Waterloo Hunt Club, its owners, employees and staff, will not be held responsible for any accidents, damage, or loss to exhibitor, property or livestock

LEHS RULES

EQUITATION DIVISIONS:

- A rider may compete in the same division throughout the entire season. That is, if a rider starts out as a Maiden, Novice, or Limit rider, they may show in that division all year no matter how many blue ribbons over fences they win.

HUNTER DIVISIONS:

- For divisions with height or oxer options, the highest height offered will be considered the height of that division and therefore may affect a rider's equitation status.

LEHS MEDAL CLASSES:

- Only one rider per horse
- To fill a class, three competitors must complete the course
- Upon receiving 2 blue ribbons in a specific medal class, the rider may not compete in that medal until the finals.
- The order of go will be posted one hour prior to the class.

Lake Effect Horse Shows Membership

Membership is not required to compete in any class. However, membership is required for the rider's and the horse's points to count toward year end prizes, including LEHS medal qualification. Membership fee is \$30.00 if paid before the end of the rider's first show. Memberships received after the completion of the rider's first show will be accepted but will be assessed a late fee of an additional \$30.00. Only one membership is needed per rider, regardless of how many horses that rider shows.

Please consider sponsoring one of our LEHS competitive divisions. Your support will help provide year-end prizes to the high point riders and horses, which will be awarded at the year-end presentation ceremony.
