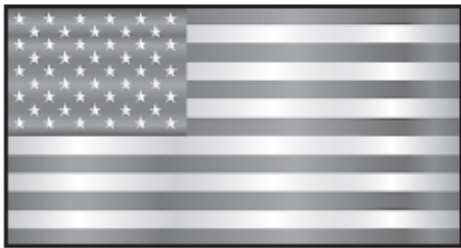
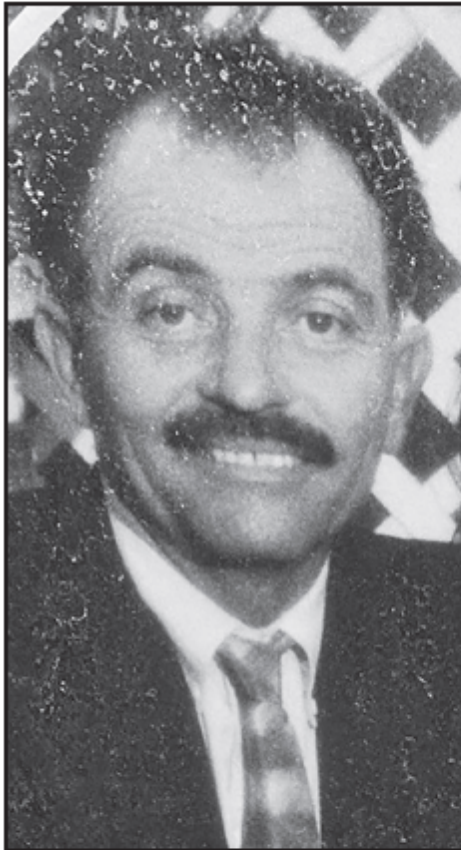


Michael Farnsworth
