AND THE LOGS THAT AREN'T GOING FOR LUMBER WILL NEED TO BE CUT AND STACKED FOR FIREWOOD.

I WAS CONTACTED YESTERDAY BY TWO LISTENERS. ONE WHO WOULD LIKE TO COME UP ON THURSDAY, WEATHER PERMITTING, TO LIMB THE LOGS AND PILE THE BRANCHES. I'M SURE THEY WOULDN'T MIND SOME HELP. AND THE OTHER CALLER HAS MACHINERY TO REMOVE THE STUMPS ALTHOUGH HE SAID HIS MACHINERY MIGHT BE TOO BIG FOR OUR JOB. SO WE WILL HAVE TO WAIT TO SEE. THERE'S NO HURRY ON THAT UNTIL AFTER ALL OF THE OTHER IS DONE.

I'M STILL LOOKING FOR SOMEONE WITH A LOGGING TRUCK. PERHAPS YOU DELIVER WOOD DOWN SOUTH AND THEN TRAVEL BACK TO THE NORTH PART OF THE STATE EMPTY. IF YOUR TRAVELS TAKE YOU CLOSE TO SURING PERHAPS YOU COULD TAKE OUR LOGS BACK WITH YOU UP NORTH TO A MILL FOR US.
