Toledo Bend Lake Association is pleased to announce that Linda Boren has been commissioned to paint the 2019 Bass Unlimited Poster. We are lucky to have someone so connected to the Toledo Bend Community. Ms. Boren and her husband Chuck moved to Toledo Bend in 1996 and became very active almost immediately. She served as President of the Art Guild for four years and was the poster artist for Bass Unlimited in 2005. She served on the Zwolle Poster Committee and was the 2009 poster artist for the Zwolle Tamale Fiesta.

Ms. Boren was a Tourist Counselor for SRA, where she was named as a Pelican State Official Ambassador for retirees and promoted Louisiana as a preferred choice for retirement. She designed and painted four of the original large fiberglass fish located around the Parish and has recently refurbished her "Lunker" fish located at the SRA office on Highway 6.

The Poster Unveiling is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. and the doors open to the public at 6:45, on Thursday, April 4, in the Cypress Bend Resort Grand Ballroom. Refreshments will be served and there will be a cash bar. Ms. Boren will be in attendance to sign and personalize posters.
