Sunrise Montessori School programs follow a schedule which is similar, **but not identical** to the Franklin public school calendar. There are **167 school days** observed during the 2025-2026 academic year (164 full days and 3 early release days).

Our school year is comprised of approximately 36 academic weeks:

September to December has approximately 15 academic weeks & January to June has approximately 21 academic weeks. **Half day** (8:30am to 11:30am), **full day** (8:30am to 2:30pm) and **full day extended** (7:30am to 5:30pm) programs are offered. An optional **a la carte extended day** program runs from 7:30am to 8:30am and 2:30pm to 5:30pm.

Sunrise Montessori School observes a two-week Winter Break, a one-week February Vacation Break and a one-week April Vacation Break.

On Professional Development Days, Parent/Teacher full day conferences, scheduled holidays, vacation breaks and snow days, school is not in session, and the Extended Day program is not available (childcare is available during your scheduled conference time slot).

There are 3 early release days scheduled for the 2025-2026 school year – **Thursday, December 4; Thursday, April 30** and the last day of school (currently **Wednesday, June 10**). On early release days all children are dismissed at 11:30am and there is no Extended Day Program available in the afternoon.

In the event that there are more than 3 snow days used during the academic year, the calendar will be revised, and additional days will be added to the school year in June. Previously scheduled Professional Development Days may also be used as snow make up days if necessary.
