SPRING HOME IMPROVEMENT GUIDE



With warmer weather approaching, the Borough would like to provide some guidance when it comes to home improvements and maintenance:

- ⊗ Grass and weeds shall not exceed six inches (Ord. 5-1987)
- ⊗ Property owners or occupants are responsible for the removal, trimming and cutting of grass, weeds, and other vegetation (Ord. 5-1987)
- ⊗ Some landscape activities require a grading permit, so you must check with the Borough regarding the project and if a permit is applicable (Ord. 5-1991)
- ⊗ Solid waste must be stored so as to prevent attraction, harborage, or breeding of insects, animals or vectors, and to assure elimination of conditions harmful to public health, or which create or might reasonably be expected to create safety hazards, odors, unsightliness, or public nuisances (Ord. 3-1992)
- ⊗ Storage containers and other properly wrapped or contained materials for trash collection may be placed at curb side no earlier than 6:00 p.m., on the day prior to the designated collection day (Friday) (Ord. 3-1992)
- ⊗ Some home improvements require a building permit (Ord. 02-1985)
- ⊗ Pool installations require a permit (Ord. 5-1998)
- ⊗ Installation or replacement of a fence require a permit (Ord. 2-1991)

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE IF YOUR PROJECT REQUIRES A PERMIT, PLEASE CONTACT THE BOROUGH OFFICE.

Be sure to adhere to all signs on your street regarding parking. Street sweeping is scheduled every second and fourth Wednesday. Please note that services may be cancelled due to illness or weather and sometimes we don't receive notice until that morning.
