DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing target recurve. This was Ben Pearson's top of the line target bow in 1973. George Birnie designed hyper-kinetic limbs. Beautiful massive riser of Marble wood and Shedua. Factory installed plunger and stabilizer inserts. This bow is a joy to shoot. Comfortable grip; Virtually no vibration. No delamination; no cracks; limbs appear straight. There was considerable crazing and yellowing of the limbs, so they have been refinished (you can see the original yellowing on the Centurion decal). Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. There are some scratches, scuffs and blemishes on the limbs. Still, this is a really nice bow in very good overall condition for its age. Comes with a string.
