



Summary Privacy notice - Shedders

What is the purpose of this document?

On 25 May 2018, data protection law will change with the introduction of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). It is a significant change for all organisations, including charities, that hold and process personal data. Brexit does not affect the introduction of this legislation as the UK will still be a member of the European Union (EU) at the date of implementation, and the government plans to incorporate the GDPR into UK law.

Age Concern Eastbourne collects and processes personal information about shedders as part of our relationship. We are committed to being transparent about how we collect and use your data to meet our obligations under the GDPR.

We will process the personal information you provide for our legitimate charitable interests and to enhance the experience of shedders.
