

Town of Clifton
Public Hearing Regarding Proposed CDBG /SSP Projects
Meeting Minutes
Town Hall, 510 N Coronado Blvd.
May 12, 2016
6:30 p.m.

The public hearing was called to order by Mayor Felix Callicotte. He turned over the discussion to Ian McGaughey, Town Manager. Mr. McGaughey reported that this meeting is an attempt to correct a possible timing deficiency in publishing and scheduling the second required public hearing in the already submitted 2015 SSP Application .

He reminded those present that in the initial hearing, members of the public were given the opportunity to suggest potential projects which might qualify as eligible projects. He reported that two projects were mentioned to include improvements to the town's wastewater system and to consider utilizing the funding for further street improvements.

Public response was again supportive of the proposed plan to focus on the town's wastewater service as it was stated that the aging system could fail at any time. In other comments, street improvements should be considered as well.

Daniel Cervantez, asked for clarification on what the wastewater improvements would entail. Mr. McGaughey explained that the project would include developing engineering plans to map out and locate the town's collection system .

Mr. McGaughey explained that upon adjournment of this public hearing, the Clifton Town Council would consider adoption of the required resolutions to include authorization to submit the application , committing local funds and adopting a relocation assistance plan as part of the regular town council meeting agenda.

There being no further comments or questions from those present, the meeting adjourned at approximately 6:28 p.m.
