ELECTION DAY: Due to election day being the 2nd Tuesday of November, the Regular Council Meeting has been scheduled on Tuesday, November 15.

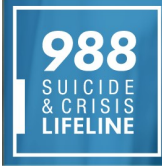
THANKSGIVING: Borough offices will be closed Thursday, November 24 and Friday, November 25. Trash service will be on Saturday due to the holiday.

WINTER MAINTENANCE & MS-4

RESIDENTIAL WALKWAYS

- * Reduce the amount of salt that you apply to your driveway and walkways.
- * Use mechanical means to remove snow/ice (i.e. shoveling, plowing, snow blowing, etc.) as much as possible.
- * Use only sand to provide traction.
- * If you have multiple entrances to your home, designate one of them as the “winter entrance” and only maintain the walkway that serves that door.

GO GREEN

- * Compost your Christmas tree instead of throwing it in the trash. Contact Allegheny CleanWays to find a location to recycle your tree.
- * Do not dump snow near waterways or storm drains.

REMINDER!!! Trash service is every Friday except for certain holidays that may fall on a weekday (New Year’s, Labor Day, Independence Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas), then it will be picked up on Saturday. All other holidays are normal service days.

Make sure all trash is put out after 6:00 p.m. the day before & placed in a secure container.

CODE ENFORCEMENT UPDATES

The Borough now utilizes Code Enforcement Agency as their Building Inspectors. They will inspect all properties for sales and rentals, provide plan reviews and issue permits for building projects on all properties. This change means that the cost of occupancy inspections has changed to the following amounts:

Residential Sales	\$90.00
Residential Rentals	\$90.00
Commercial Sales	\$125.00
Commercial Rentals	\$90.00
