SENT BY THE ANGEL OF THE LORD
VISION TO THE PROPHET ZECHARIAH**

REVELATION AND UNDERSTANDING CORRELATING TO 2 CHRONICLES 16:9.

“For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him.” The vision of Zechariah came as encouragement to him and the people of Israel in a time of great oppression, captivity, a sense of hopelessness, and their temple could never be rebuilt or the city replenished. Zechariah is commissioned by God to encourage the people in the unfinished responsibility of building, to motivate the people to seek God, reminding them to take action for the future work of restoring and building the temple of God, bringing about restoration of the people with reliance on God and His Spirit.

***THE VISION TO THE PROPHET ZECHARIAH, CHAPTER
ZECHARIAH 4:1-3, 6, 10:***

- Zechariah did not know what the vision of the golden candlestick and olive trees meant, and the angel of the Lord talked with him and walked with him as a man, he was awakened out of sleep. The angel presented the question, ***“What seest thou?”*** Today, the Lord is asking, ***“What do you see?”*** From the unveiling of this message. Sometimes, we must simply ask if we cannot see meaning, ***“What are these, my Lord?”*** Wait for the response, and accept the answer.
- The Word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, is the Word to us today, ***“Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit saith the LORD of hosts.”*** (Zechariah 4:6). We must seek the Lord and His strength to accomplish the great work invested in us, not to compromise, and make treaty with the enemies. Knowing, there is absolutely nothing too hard for God.
- The Spirit of God has the omnipotent power to raise up, stand up, and fortify people, when Satan and people counted them out. In the ***“process of time”*** God does not forget about His spoken Word. He comes to give Grace, grace, unto those with a loyal heart and soul in changing seasons and appointed times.
- The church is a candlestick, set up for the enlightening of this dark world and the holding forth of the light of divine revelation to it. The candle is God’s; the church is but the candlestick, but all of gold, denoting the great worth and excellence of the church of God. God has given Christ Jesus as head of the body of the church (Colossians 1:18).
- The foundation is laid by God, in which He will finish His foundation. We are not to despise the day of small things. God makes all things great in His hands. The seven lamps are ***“the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.”*** (Zechariah 4:10).
- This candlestick had one bowl, or common receiver, on the top, into which oil was continually dropping, and from it, by seven secret pipes, or passages, it was diffused to the seven lamps. The oil is the anointing flowing from Heaven to the people of God. The anointing diffuses to the people of God, to do the will of God without compromise.
- **Stay strong, Stay Loyal to the Lord, Because He is Watching!** Jesus is the Light for us today, the oil of His Spirit flowing from Heaven, to His church, to be a light, to bring forth His purpose of salvation and deliverance. ***“Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.”*** (John 8:12).
