Opening – Brian Boehm:

Secretary's Report – Jon Speck:

Treasurer's Report – Bill Means:

- YTD dues income is \$11,800 and corresponding expenditures of \$16,630. We currently do not have a renter in the house.
- Primarily, we had utility bills and building liability insurance was almost \$2000.
- The other big expense was the house as we fix up the carpeting and floors. We spent \$2100 on that so far with more work needed.
- We have a new lawn mower.

Membership Report – Steve Close:

- As of this date we have 81 regular members and 9 senior members for a total of 90. Dues collected are \$1,100, 15 dues reminders and no work credits were issued. There are no 1st or 2nd readings this month.

Rifle Team – Jon Speck:

- It was a busy junior shooting summer with several juniors shooting all of the nationals matches (ASSA, NRA and CMP).
- Southport had 2 teams at the ASSA Nationals and the 2 – 2 person teams took 1st and 2nd place out of a total of 16 teams participating.
- At the NRA Nationals, AJ Hotko won the National 3P Championship (Frank Parson's Memorial Trophy) and Lara Spanic placed 3rd out of 41 competitors.
- Lara Spanic won the WI 3P State Championship held at the Green County Rifle Range in Monroe, WI
- Emme and Dylan Gregory place 1st and 2nd in the IL State Prone Championships. Dylan, being a IL resident, won the State Prone Championship Title.

- In the National 3PAR Junior Olympic Championship (Camp Perry), Emme place 5th in the Individual matches and won the finals in a shoot-off. In the National 3PAR Junior Championship the next day, she placed 4th in the Individual matches and won the finals.
