Trail Report (Duane D) Duane has been walking the trails and noting areas that need attention. Noting trail markers that are knocked down or missing, and repairing if possible. The "stairs" trail out of camp needs attention and will be a big project, but the club can start with a general cleanup/trimming effort and evaluate from there. There was discussion of talking to the DNR about an "adopt a trail" effort, where members could pick a section of trail convenient to them to clean up garbage, prune foliage and report general issues.

Old Business

Possible second pen at the host site. Replace current pen and make it 2 pens. Project on hold for now. **Host Site Hoses** - 300ft of hose donated by member Amy McCray. Duane and Deb will be stopping by the DNR office with questions, and will ask if it is possible to install a spigot on the bathhouse to run hoses to, instead of all the way to the doghouse or supply by main entrance. More hoses may be needed, TBD

Fencing along exposed roadside campsites - discussion of cost of fence vs installing pens in the sites along the road. General consensus is it might be more cost effective to install pens, while also making those sites more desirable. We will price out pen panels from a few suppliers, this could be our main goal/fundraising effort.

Wheelbarrows - replace some of the wheels with the no flat tires and tag them with our info so they will be less likely to be stolen. The two new barrows donated by Cyndi Merka have been labeled and are in use. Inventory will need to be taken of wheel/axle sizes needed.
