- Psalm 1:3, He will be standing firm like a flourishing tree planted by God's design, deeply rooted by the brooks of bliss, bearing fruit in every season of his life. He is never dry, never fainting, ever blessed, ever prosperous.
- Psalm 3:8, My true hero comes to my rescue, for the Lord alone is my Savior. What a feast of favor and bliss he gives his people! Pause in his presence
- Psalm 16:11, For you bring me a continual revelation of resurrection life, the path to the bliss that brings me face-to-face with you.
- Psalm 21:6, Your victory heaps blessing after blessing upon him. What joy and bliss he tastes, rejoicing before your face!
- Psalm 23:2, He offers a resting place for me in his luxurious love. His tracks take me to an oasis of peace, the quiet brook of bliss.
- Psalm 30:12, How could I be silent when it's time to praise you? Now my heart sings out loud, bursting with joy— a bliss inside that keeps me singing, "I can never thank you enough!"
- Psalm 45:7, You are passionate for righteousness and you hate lawlessness. This is why God, your God, crowns you with bliss above your fellow kings. He has anointed you, more than any other, with his oil of fervent joy, the very fragrance of heaven's gladness.

- Psalm 104:35, Now, let all the sinners be swept from the earth. But I will keep on praising you, my Lord, with all that is within me. My joyous, blissful shouts of “Hallelujah” are all because of you!
- Psalm 112:10, But the wicked take one look at a life lived like this and they grit their teeth in anger, not understanding their bliss. The wicked slink away speechless in the darkness that falls, where hope dies and all their dreams fade away to nothing, nothing at all!
- Psalm 144:15, What bliss we experience when these blessings fall! The people who love and serve our God will be happy indeed!
- Psalm 145:7, Our hearts bubble over as we celebrate the fame of your marvelous beauty, bringing bliss to our hearts. We shout with ecstatic joy over your breakthrough for us.
- Proverbs 29:18, When there is no clear prophetic vision, people quickly wander astray. But when you follow the revelation of the word, heaven’s bliss fills your soul.
- Song of Songs 8:2, I long to bring you to my innermost chamber— this holy sanctuary you have formed within me. O that I might carry you within me. I would give you the spiced wine of my love, this full cup of bliss that we share. We would drink our fill until . . .
- Song of Songs 8:8-10, My brothers said to me when I was young, “Our sister is so immature. What will we do to guard her for her wedding day?” [The Bridegroom-King] We will

build a tower of redemption to protect her. Since she is vulnerable, we will enclose her with a wall of cedar boards. [The Shulamite Bride] But now I have grown and become a bride, and my love for him has made me a tower of passion and contentment for my beloved. I am now a firm wall of protection for others, guarding them from harm. This is how he sees me—I am the one who brings him bliss, finding favor in his eyes.

- Isaiah 25:9, In that day they will say, “Behold! This is our God! We’ve waited for him, and he saved us! This one, the Lord Yahweh—he is worth the wait! We will keep shouting with joy as we find our bliss in his salvation-kiss!”
- Isaiah 30:18, For this reason the Lord is still waiting to show his favor to you so he can show you his marvelous love. He waits to be gracious to you. He sits on his throne ready to show mercy to you. For Yahweh is the Lord of justice, faithful to keep his promises. Overwhelmed with bliss are all who will entwine their hearts in him, waiting for him to help them.
- Isaiah 45:7, I create light, and I make it dark. I make bliss, and I create adversity. I am Yahweh who does all these things.’
- Isaiah 51:3, Indeed, Yahweh will comfort Zion, restore her, and comfort all her broken places. He will transform her wilderness into the garden of Bliss, her desert into the garden of Yahweh. Joy and laughter will fill the air with thanksgiving and joyous melodies.

- Isaiah 58:14, then you will find the joyous bliss that comes from serving Yahweh. And I will cause you to prosper and be carried triumphantly over the high places of the land. You will enjoy the heritage of Jacob, your ancestor.” Certainly the mouth of Yahweh has spoken it!
- Isaiah 61:3, to strengthen those crushed by despair who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful bouquet in the place of ashes, the oil of bliss instead of tears, and the mantle of joyous praise instead of the spirit of heaviness. Because of this, they will be known as Mighty Oaks of Righteousness, planted by Yahweh as a living display of his glory.
- Isaiah 61:7, Because you received a double dose of shame and dishonor, you will inherit a double portion of endless joy and everlasting bliss!
- Matthew 5:8, “What bliss you experience when your heart is pure! For then your eyes will open to see more and more of God.
- Matthew 25:46, And they will depart from his presence and go into eternal punishment. But the godly and beloved ‘sheep’ will enter into eternal bliss.”
- 2 Corinthians 5:13, If we are out of our minds in a blissful, divine ecstasy, it is for God, but if we are in our right minds, it is for your benefit.
- Hebrews 1:9, For you have cherished righteousness and detested lawlessness. For this reason, God, your God, has

anointed you and poured out the oil of bliss on you more than on any of your friends.”
