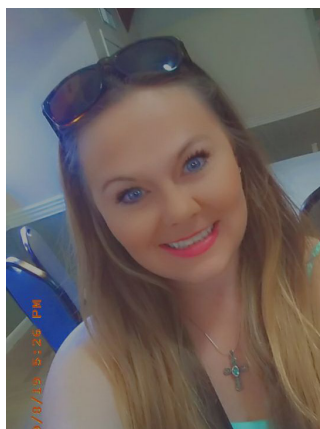


Introducing Ashley
