
### ♡ Sweetheart Ball – February 15



### Barbara Barishman





## HELLO FROM YOUR A SQUARE D DELEGATE

What is A Square D? Who is a Delegate and why am I writing this column? Let's take A Square D first. A Square D stands for "Associated Square Dancers" and we shorten it to ASD when we are writing about it. ASD is a non-profit organization formed to support square dance clubs. ASD is local to southern California and consists of about 12 square Dance Clubs like Trail Dusters. Each club appoints an ASD delegate and I, Bradz Dad (aka Bill Dickter), am the Trail Dusters' delegate to ASD.

The club delegates meet once a month to hear about what is going on within the ASD organization and we discuss activities that pertain to the member clubs. The delegates share what is happening in their respective clubs, the good, the bad, and - there is no ugly - club status and issues. These meetings are a great opportunity to find out what is going on in the other clubs and submit ideas, recommendations and the like to ASD to consider.

ASD provides a recommended list of calls for clubs' callers to teach. Our Michael Kellogg is teaching from this list. In addition, ASD has organized a process in which all member clubs and their members have insurance (it's included in your membership) if the unlikely accident happens at a dance.

ASD sponsors dances for all the clubs. The upcoming dance on **January 25** is special for this club, **The Student Stomp** is the first opportunity for our Rail Dusters to experience a real square dance. A flier for the dance is included on page 8 of this Dusty Trails. We need our members, yes, that includes you, to come to the dance to support our newbies.

ASD has yet another dance scheduled, the **Sweetheart Ball** on **February 15**. Here is when clubs honor their Sweethearts. Each couple is announced at the Ball and walks through the hall where the attendees can get a look at our special sweethearts. Our Sweethearts are Patti and Marshal Goldberg who have worked hard to keep Trail Dusters going including supporting our Rail Dusters. See our Sweetheart flier on page 9 & the ASD flier on page 10.


