OLD BUSINESS

- I. **Shop for Schools:** We are waiting on final numbers.

NEW BUSINESS

- I. Hawthorne Vision: Friday, Jan 31. It will be an international fair. The committee sent out an email for food donations and contacts. They currently are in need of volunteers. This year they will have an ambassador for each continent plus one for an allergy table. The Ambassador will be responsible for coordinating food (nut free), education, activities and volunteers. The committee will continue to ask for assistance and send communication.
- II. **Holiday Fair, Dec 12:** We have over 25 students set up for the holiday craft fair. It looks like the temperature is about 30 degrees. It will be outside. The committee needs a huge push for volunteers to set up at 3:45pm. Also, we need tables for the event.

- V. **Spring Social: The date is Friday, March 7.** The theme is "ALL IN." The auctioneer is not available. However, he did have a referral. Natsumi and Jackie will do interviews and sourcing for auctioneers. Kristy is helping with donations. We have parent volunteers for making baskets. The committee will send out a sign up for additional committees.
