




WE RECOMMEND . . . 62" for draws up to 27". 64" for draws up to 28". 66" for draws up to 29". 68" for draws up to 31". HB, 58" and 62" for draws up to 30" and weights to 65 pounds. H10, 60" for draws up to 30" and weights to 65 pounds.



The beautiful finish on Black Widow Bows is an exceptionally durable Epoxy coating. Handle sections are Black Walnut and Brazilian Rosewood. White glass is used on front and back of all models.

If you wish your name inscribed on your bow there is no charge for this service.

Handle shapes for all models are standard as shown. When requested we will also make what is called the "California" high, or straight wrist; or a semi-high wrist handle shape. Also variations in measurements of the standard handle shape if you wish.

The Wilson Brothers make only first line bows.
