#### Being Built Into A Spiritual House By W.R.

"And you are living stones that God is building into His spiritual temple. What's more, you are His holy priests. Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God." (1 Peter 2:5) Scripture here from God's Word, tells us that we are living stones in a spiritual house. Some of us are diamonds in the rough, rubies and other precious gems.

Jesus worked as a carpenter when He was living here on this earth, but He never built a house in one day. And the good news is this ... God tells us in His Word that, "And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue His work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns." (Philippians 1:6)

Jesus is the foundation of our house. The beams, inner structure of a house is what gives it strength and durability and as living beings the Holy Spirit is our inner strength. In *Psalm 127:1*, Scripture tells us, "Unless the LORD builds a house, the work of the builders is wasted. Unless the LORD protects a city, guarding it with sentries will do no good." And then Jesus, in *Matthew 7:24-27*, affirms, "Anyone who listens to lifty teaching and follows it is wise, lifte a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrants and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. But anyone who hears lift teaching and doesn't obey it is toolish, lifte a person who builds a house on send. When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mightly creati." As Christians we will always find ourselves in a storm, coming out of one or getting ready to go into one.

When I was on death row and the guards would escort me across the yard, people would always holler, in a loud voice, "Dead Man walking", and all movement would come to a halt. Before coming to the Cross, Christ Jesus, we all were dead men/women walking. Why? Because Romans 6:23 tells us, "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord."

When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead the Word of God tells us, "Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come (John 11:43) It's the same for us today. Jesus is still calling for us to "Come cut" or "Come for the Cross, to shed our grave cloths as He resurrects us into a new life. For we are bound, not in grave cloths, but in sin, in old habits, attitudes, addictions and all sorts of things that keep us bound.

When the Hebrew people were delivered from bondage in Egypt, God led them into the desert. This was a place in which they did not feel comfortable, for they were out of their element. After a short period of time they started complaining that they were better off in Egypt ... that they had no cucumbers to eat. After 400 years in bondage you would think that they would be rejoicing. Though they were free, they still had a slave mentality. Even today, we all have been conditioned, by our experiences and environments, to think and respond in a certain manner to people AND situations.

A good example of that is the Apostle Peter. The night Jesus was arrested, John 18:10 tells us, "Then Simon Peter, who had a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear. (The servant's name was Malchus.)" For three and a half years Peter walked with Jesus, set up under His teachings, healed people, cast out demons and other than Jesus, Peter was the only other man to walk on water. You would think that he would have responded differently, but Peter too was still being built into that spiritual house 1 Peter 2:5 told us about. The Lord was still working on his house, He is still working on mine, as I'm sure He is still working on all of us. Some people have been Christians for years and the Lord is still in the basement of their houses!

Like Peter, there are times in which you too feel like cutting someone's ear off, I'm sure. Why is that? It could be that you are still chained to your old mind set. This is why the Word tells us, "Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes." (NIV), "And be renewed in the spirit of your mind." (KJV) (Ephesians 4:23) This doesn't happen overnight any more so than a carpenter can build a house overnight. If that weren't the case, then Peter would never have cut that mans ear off! Our old nature, the sinful nature, doesn't die overnight for it's always there lingering in the shadows, waiting to resurrect itself!

Recently, I took my Bible and went into the shower to pray. When I got in there I saw a frog sitting there in the corner just looking at me. I spoke to it and said, "The God that I serve didn't create you to hang out in the shower, you're out of your element! Like that frog and the Hebrew people in the desert, we too are out of our element until we come to the Cross, to Christ.

When Adam was in the Garden of Eden he was in the element that God intended. For God created us to have communion and a personal relationship with Him, to glorify Him. But, when Adam sinned he was cast out of the Garden of Eden. Not because God hated Adam but so that he couldn't eat from the Tree of Life and live forever. God still loved Adam but his sin separated him from the Garden, the true relationship that God had intended for them/him. And like Adam we too are out of our true intended element/relationship with God until we come to the Cross, to Christ.

The Word tells us that our spirits are at war with our flesh and every time we yield to the flesh and it's desires, we are out of our element, spiritually, and the Holy Spirit reminds us of that by convicting us. Everyone sitting in a prison cell were at some point in their life, out of their element with God! Every time we sin, we separate ourselves from God, He doesn't separate Himself from us. *Hebrews 13:5* affirms this, "*Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.*" Sin puts us out of our element, but the Holy Spirit is always calling and redirecting us back to Him.

God didn't create us to use drugs, to sell drugs or to do any of the things that brought us to prison any more so than the frog that was in that shower. And we, like that frog, were out of our element when we did the things that we did. It was our disobedience that brought us all to these prisons. The choices that we made in our lives took us out of our homes, our communities and out of our element separating us from God. And like the frog in the shower God didn't create us to live in a cell in prison. Everyone in prison is out of their element.

God didn't create us to be put in chains, but we chain ourselves to our home boys, to gangs, drugs and all those things that keep us bound. We forge our own links to those chains by the choices that we make. We become the jailers of our own prisons. Second Peter 2:19 says this, "They promise them freedom, while they themselves are slaves of depravity—for 'people are slaves to whatever has mastered them." So again, in that sense, we are the jailers of our own prisons. But, we can still be free even in these chains. For God has made a way to bring us out of our prisons, to free us from our chains and all those things that keep us bound.

God has given us the key to our prisons, to our chains and that Key, Jesus, was hung on a Cross over 2000 years ago to restore us to our natural element. Jesus came to bridge the gap that once separated us from God. And now, God is extending His hand to you today beckoning you to come to the Cross, to take the Key, to set yourself free. Just as Jesus called Lazarus from his tomb, God is calling you to come to the Cross!

The only question left is, "Will you choose to come?" In *Deuteronomy 30:19* God states this, "Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!" So this verse indicates that the choices 'we' make today, not only do they affect our lives, but they also affect the lives of our children as well.

Before the Hebrew people went into the Promise Land Joshua told them, "But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve," (Joshua 24:15) Your promise land is waiting beyond these gates and don't be mistaken, as it says in Jeremiah 29:11, "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Today, you can only see the promise land from afar but you don't have to wait to get to that location where you may be going to choose who you are going to serve.

I am doing two natural life sentences and can only see the Promise Land from afar, from a distance. For my Promise Land awaits me in the New Jerusalem and I am at peace with that. My prayer is that one day I will see each and every one of you that lays eyes on this article there, too! My prayer is that you too will go to the Cross and take the Key that will open the door to Paradise, the New Jerusalem!



You have asked me a few times to share my testimony. I do know that we are saved by the Blood of Jesus and the words of our testimony (*Revelation 12:11*) but I'm afraid that if I told you it all, it would be 100 pages. So, I'll start out when I first came to believe in Christ as my Savior.

I was born into a Catholic Church. I went to Catholic school through the fifth grade. I never once heard of the saving grace of Jesus nor one word about the truth in the Bible. The first time that I heard the Gospel, I was on the beach in Huntington. But the first time I believed I was in Clark County jail in Las Vegas. I was in the hole for fighting and someone slid the book, Prison to Praise under my cell door. It was while I was reading that book that I fell to my knees and cried out to Jesus. That's when I asked Him to forgive me of my sins, come into my life and help me to go and sin no more.

When I started reading the Bible for myself, that's when I found out that almost everything the Catholic Church taught me the Bible says don't do was only the law part. So, if you're Catholic and you're reading this, I encourage you to read the Bible for yourself. It's been a long road since then because I never got a hold of 'the repentance' part of the Gospel until about ten years ago. I was stuck on Jesus' forgiveness and in 2009 California struck me out. I choose to have joy now and the Holy Spirit gives me the power to sin less and less. - J.C.

Out there and even in here, I can only imagine, but I would think that this may be a great time to get closer to God and family. I hope all of you are well and thanks again for everything. #### Isaiah 51:1-57:14

Abraham was only one man but look how much came from his faithfulness. Just think how much could come if we were to all show that same faithfulness. (51:1-2)

If people give you grief because of your faith in God they are not after you personally but after God. God will deal with them. (51:7)

It is a great privilege to be able to share the Good News of God with others. His news of salvation, peace, and redemption is for all to receive. (52:7)

Christ would become 'disfigured' but because of His suffering all nations could be cleansed. (52:14-15)

Who could believe that God chose to save the world not with a glorious king but with a suffering, humble Servant. (53:1)

In the Old Testament, animals were offered up in sacrifice for sin now the sinless Servant of the Lord offered up Himself for all our sins. (53:7-12)

Food costs money, lasts only a short time, and meets only physical needs. But God offers us free nourishment that feeds our souls. How do we get it? We are to come (55:1), listen (55:2), seek and call on God (55:6). God's salvation is freely offered, but to nourish our souls we must eagerly receive it. We will starve without this food, as surely as, we will starve physically without our daily bread. (55:1-6)

Isaiah clearly proclaims the radical message that God's blessings are for all people. Whatever your race, social position, work or financial situation, God's blessings are as much for you as for anyone else. No one must exclude in anyway those God chooses to bless. (56:3)

#### Philippians 1:1-26

When we speak fearlessly for Christ or live faithfully for Him during difficult situations, we encourage others to do the same. Be an encouragement by the way that you live. (1:14)

#### Psalm 71:1-24

A person is never too old to serve God, never too old to pray. Though age may stop us from certain physical activities, it need not end our desire to tell others, especially children, about all we have seen God do in our many years of life. (71:18)

#### Proverbs 24:17-20

David, Solomon's father, refused to gloat over the death of his long time enemy, Saul. (2 Samuel 1) On the other hand, the nation of Edom rejoiced over Israel's defeat and was punished by God for their attitude. (Obadiah 1:12) To gloat over others misfortunes is to make yourself the answer and to put yourself in the place of God, who alone is the real judge of all the earth. See **Deuteronomy 32:35**. (24:17-18)

#### Eye of Your Understanding By G.B.B.

The book of *Ephesians* was written to show you what God has already done. The prayers listed in Ephesians don't petition God for something new, but that the eye of your understanding be enlightened to see what you already have.

## "Asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowing and knowledge of God. I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope He has given to those He called His holy people, who are His rich and glorious inheritance." Ephesians 1:17-18 NLT

Note how *Ephesians 2:1* is written in past tense; a "done deal" perspective: "*And you hath He quickened & made alive who were dead in trespasses and sins ..."* (KJV) If you've received Jesus, you've been made alive. But, as a bornagain believer, you have been quickened. You may not have manifested (realized and experienced) the life of God in you, but your spirit is as alive as it will ever be. Even though your physical body may be hurting, and your soul (mind/heart/emotions) may be wrestling with depression, hurts, etc., your born-again spirit is alive, the way Jesus is alive.

You have God's resurrection power inside you. You aren't trying to be made alive; you were made alive in the spirit realm.

Through faith, you can draw that life out of your spirit and into your soul and body. Pray according to God's Word, understanding who you are and what you have in Jesus. Don't pray and petition God from a place of unbelief, opposite the Word. Here's an example: "Father, I thank You that I have resurrection life inside of me. There is a sickness working in my body, so I'm drawing out Your life, which is in me. I thank You that it is already done. I take my authority and command sickness to leave my body, and for my healing to manifest, in Jesus name."

Ephesians 2:2 says, "You used to live in sin, just like the rest of the world, obeying the devil-the commander of the powers in the hearts of those who refuse to obey God." Notice how following and being dominated by satan was something in the past. You might be thinking, "I'm a Christian, but I'm still dominated by the powers of darkness." If that's so, it's because **Ephesians 2:1** isn't reality for you. You don't understand how you've already been made alive (quickened) and delivered from the death that was in trespass and sin. When you truly understand that you've been made alive, it breaks the power of sin, and you live in victory. Your life will be characterized by victory instead of defeat.

It's not that you reach sinless perfection and never make a mistake; it's just that when you understand and acknowledge that Jesus has already done it, that you already have resurrection life and you are as Jesus, in the spirit, victory is an inevitable by-product.

And I am praying that you will put into action the generosity that comes from your faith, as you understand and experience all the good things we have in Christ. (*Philemon 6*) Your faith works and you'll see victory manifest physically, financially, emotionally, etc., as you acknowledge every good thing in you, in Christ.

This isn't something to seek after or try to attain unto. It's something to be received as a gift, it is already done, and you are already in relationship with God. You are raised from the dead (spiritually) and you are now seated with Jesus in heavenly places. "Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know Gods will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect." (Romans12:2)
