



Sylvia Kathleen Wisner, 81, of Lake Twp, died Monday, September 7, 2015 at McLaren Bay Region Medical Center in Bay City.

Sylvia was born July 25, 1934 in Detroit to the late Hugh Cecil and Evelyn (Vollans) Edgar.
