ORDINANCE O-2015-21

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT
OF SANDRA ASHBA AS ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
OFFICE MANAGER

WHEREAS, Amelia Village has a vacancy for an Administrative Manager, and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Mayor, Council desires to appoint Sandra Ashba to fill the vacancy as Administrative Manager for Amelia Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Village Council does hereby confirm the Mayor's probationary appointment of Sandra Ashba, as Administrative Manager for Amelia Village, beginning April 6, 2015.

SECTION II. Sandra Ashba shall serve a probationary period of one year, at such time the Mayor with the concurrence of Village Council shall remove her from the position or upon successful completion of the probationary period appoint her to as permanent Administrative Manager for Amelia Village.

SECTION III. Mrs. Ashba's beginning salary shall be set at \$46,000 annually, and she shall be eligible for all benefits provided to full-time Village employees.

SECTION V. That the Amelia Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the position of Administrative Manager has been vacant for several weeks and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary administrative services to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MRS. KRAFKA moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.


