

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-08**

**City of Newton, Illinois  
Resolution of Funding Support for 2016 Illinois  
Transportation Enhancement Program Grant Project**

**WHEREAS:** the Newton City Council wants to support multi-use paths that encourage a safe route for pedestrian and bike traffic as well as economic development; and

**WHEREAS:** the Council is committed to the completion of Eagle Trails multi-use paths by making them more accommodating and/or accessible for pedestrian/bike use. The project will connect previously completed phases along the Embarras River Bridge, along the River Front, Peterson Park and the Aquatic Center.

**WHEREAS:** the Council understands that pedestrian/bike facilities will provide worthwhile benefits; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Newton has received **\$1,056,000** from the 2016 Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program and support the project by providing the required local match with **\$264,000** in funding or donations as defined under the Federal Flexible Match Program.


