



Calling all facilitators --- new and experienced! It's time to think outside the box and expand our reach to evenings or the weekend for the 2017 - 2018 Study Group Season.



In this debut novel, Jeffrey Marshall re-creates the life of legendary sharpshooter Annie Oakley. The book is based largely on actual events and timelines but imagines the places she saw, conversations she had and people she met, including Queen Victoria, P.T. Barnum and Thomas Edison. The book spotlights Annie's years with Buffalo Bill's Wild West Show, which catapulted her to international fame in the late 1880s, and details the amazing shooting

feats that made her unique. It also chronicles the loving marriage between Annie and Frank Butler, her husband and manager for 50 years.

On Thursday, April 20th, the Men of Brandeis are touring the Water Reclamation Plant at 8787 E Hualapai Drive in Scottsdale. The plant treats 20 million gallons of wastewater each day. The reused water is used to irrigate golf courses, city parks, and medians. It is a relatively new plant using a variety of technologies to remove salt and other minerals, making the water safe to use on golf courses in the northern part of Scottsdale. 


